

Works notice

Overnight sewer connection works

Tuesday 22 August to Thursday 31 August 2023

We're closing Osborne Street for four nights in August to connect the egress building's sewer to the main sewer network.

What we are doing

- Closing Osborne Street for four nights so that we can install new sewer pipes under the road and connect them into the main sewer system
- Using road saws and excavators to cut through and remove part of the road
- Installing new pipes to connect the egress building's sewer to the main sewer network
- Backfilling and asphaltting the road.

What to be aware of

- These works must take place at night to minimise traffic impacts
- These works are expected to generate periods of high levels of noise associated with the use of the road saw. Noisier activities such as saw cutting will be scheduled to take place early in the shift where possible
- There will be no vehicle access or on-street parking, between Toorak Road and 139 Osborne Street from 5pm to 5am each night
- Access to residential properties will be maintained via Davis Avenue and Fawkner Street under the guidance of traffic controllers.

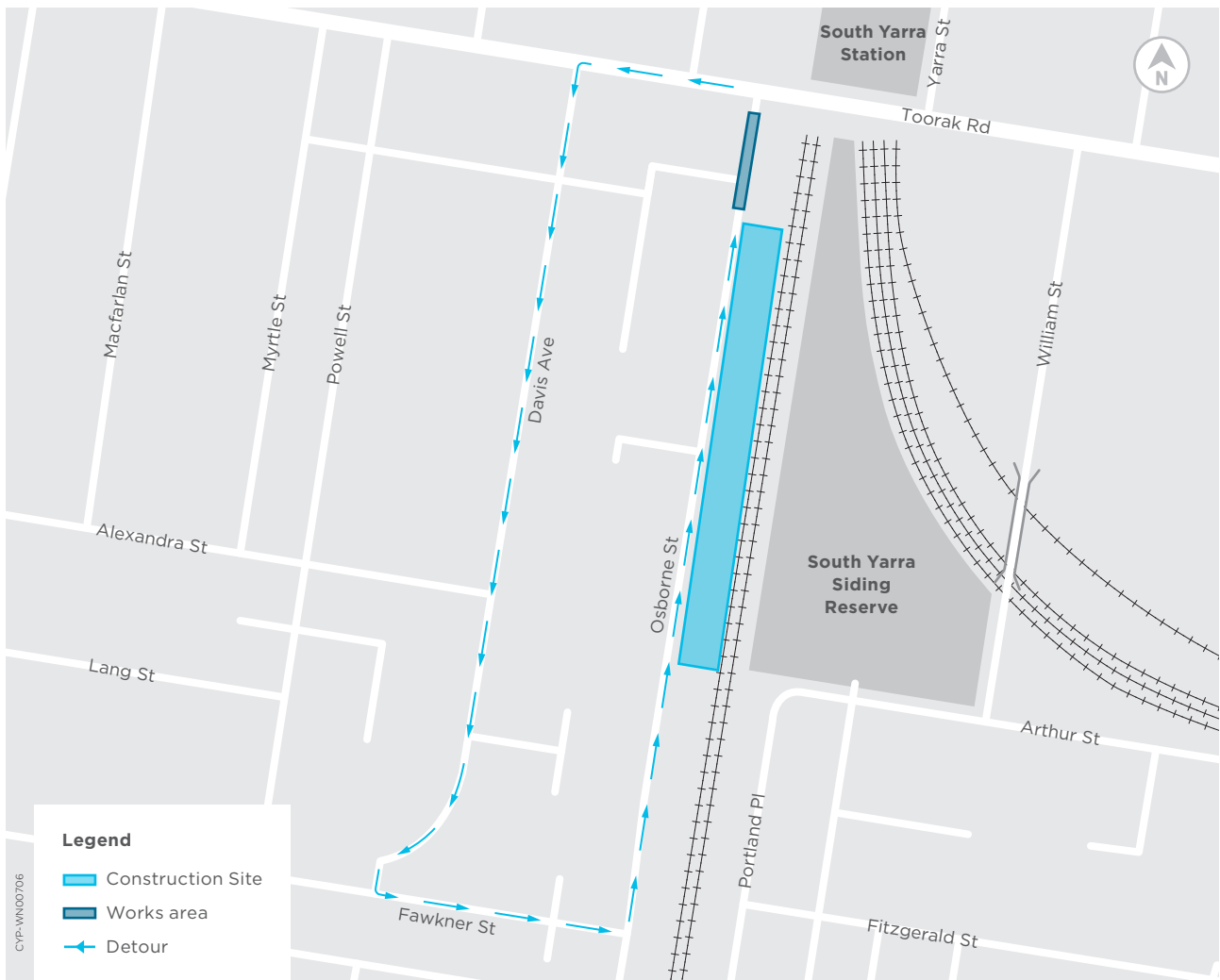
When

- These work will take place over four nights from 5pm to 5am, between Tuesday 22 August and Saturday 26 August
- Due to the critical nature of these sewer works, if there is inclement weather or any other unexpected delays, works may also take place overnights from 5pm to 5am, Monday 28 August to 5am Friday 1 September
- Other works will continue within the site during standard construction hours.
