

# Works notice

## Haymarket roundabout pedestrian crossing closure Elizabeth Street, Parkville

**Mid-September to early December 2023**

From mid-September until early December, traffic signalling, median and kerb works will take place on Elizabeth Street on the northern side of the Haymarket roundabout as part of early works to upgrade the tram route 19 stop 10 on Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade.

To enable these works, the northern pedestrian crossing on Elizabeth Street, north of the Haymarket roundabout, will close from mid-September until early December.

### What we are doing

- Adjustments to footpath and kerb on Elizabeth Street
- Adjustments to traffic signal infrastructure.

### What to be aware of

- The northern pedestrian crossing on Elizabeth Street, north of the Haymarket roundabout, will close to pedestrians from mid-September to early December
- Pedestrians will be detoured north to the pedestrian crossing at the intersection of Grattan and Elizabeth streets
- Cyclists crossing east to west on Elizabeth Street will dismount at the Haymarket roundabout and be diverted to the north to the Grattan Street and Elizabeth Street intersection
- Cyclists moving west to east will be able to utilise the existing cycling lane on the northern side of the Haymarket roundabout
- These works are expected to generate periods of medium to high level noise and some vibration.

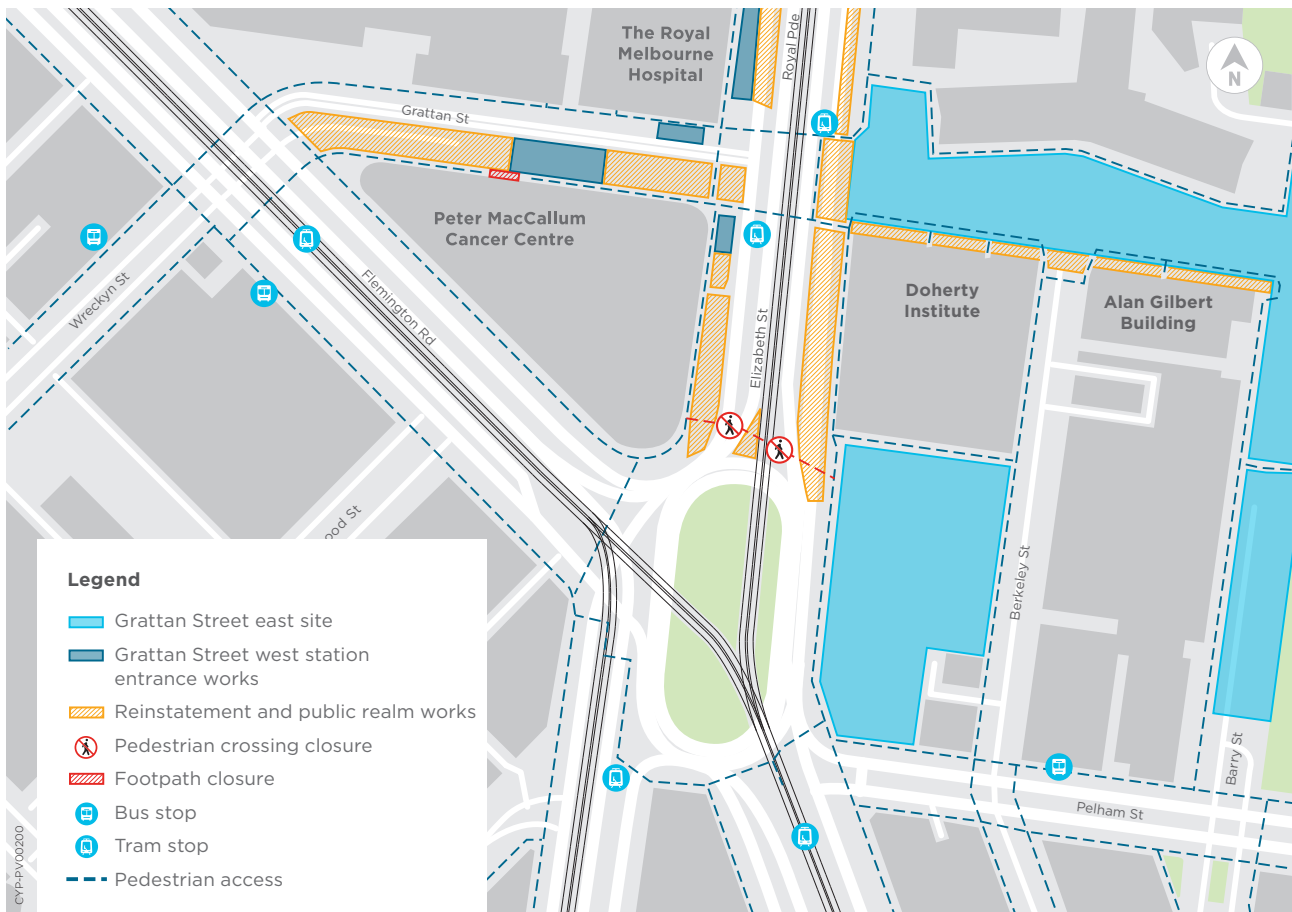
### When

- Construction works will be carried out during standard working hours (from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and from 7am to 1pm Saturdays).
