

NARRE WARREN-CRANBOURNE ROAD UPGRADE



DECEMBER 2023

To limit disruption in Cranbourne and its neighbouring suburbs during summer, we've made changes to our construction program.

More than \$28 billion dollars has been invested to improve infrastructure in Melbourne's south-east across several key road upgrades.

Over November and December, great progress has been made, removing the Camms Road level crossing and upgrading the Hall Road and Western Port Highway intersection as part of Victoria's Big Build.

Works will continue at Hall Road in January with the Hall, Evans and Cranbourne roads intersection closed for up to 10 days. During this closure, delays are expected of around 20 minutes while vehicles detour via Thompsons Road, Western Port Highway, Ballarto Road and Frankston-Dandenong Road.

To reduce travel times across the network, we've delayed Stage 2 works on the Berwick-Cranbourne Road intersection upgrade. We planned to start Stage 2 works in January by opening Cameron Street and closing the northern half of the roundabout. As this change will further increase traffic using South Gippsland Highway, we've changed our plans and will keep Cameron Street closed throughout February.

In February, when major works are complete on the Hall Road Upgrade, we'll reopen Cameron Street and close Narre Warren-Cranbourne Road at Berwick-Cranbourne Road to finish building the new intersection.

Vehicles will be detoured via Thompsons Road and South Gippsland Highway.

This closure will remain in place until late May.

To further minimise disruptions, we'll also delay reconfiguring the intersection and installing temporary signals at the junction of Cameron Street and South Gippsland Highway until most of the summer travel is over. We'd planned to do this work in mid-December but will now complete this in late January to minimise delays on the South Gippsland Highway.


