

Works notice



Albert Road overnight asphalting

Albert Road

From 8pm Wednesday 17 January to 6am Thursday 18 January 2024

As part of the finishing works for the Metro Tunnel Project in the Anzac precinct, the final layer of asphalt will be laid on the eastern end of Albert Road up to St Kilda Road.



When we'll be working

- Traffic setup will take place from **8pm on Wednesday 17 January 2024**
- Driveway closures of 1 Albert Road (The Domain), 18 Albert Road (Domain Hill), 22 Albert Road, 24 Albert Road and 38 Albert Road will begin from **11pm Wednesday 17 January 2024**
- Driveways and Albert Road access from St Kilda Road will be reopened by **5am Thursday 18 January 2024**
- Due to the nature of these works, progress may be impacted by weather conditions.

What we'll be doing

- Closing access into Albert Road from St Kilda Road and maintaining access via Kings Way
- Closing access to driveways at 1 Albert Road (The Domain), 18 Albert Road (Domain Hill), 22 Albert Road, 24 Albert Road and 38 Albert Road from 11pm while we lay the asphalt
- Laying the final layer of asphalt along this section of Albert Road
- Line marking the road.

What to be aware of

- During the works, access in and out of Albert Road will be via Kings Way
- Driveways at 1 Albert Road (The Domain), 18 Albert Road (Domain Hill), 22 Albert Road, 24 Albert Road and 38 Albert Road will be closed from 11pm and will reopen at 5am
- No other driveways will be closed during these works
- These works are expected to generate periods of medium levels of noise associated with the laying of asphalt
- Traffic controllers will be in place on Albert Road to assist safe traffic U-turns and pedestrian movements along Albert Road.

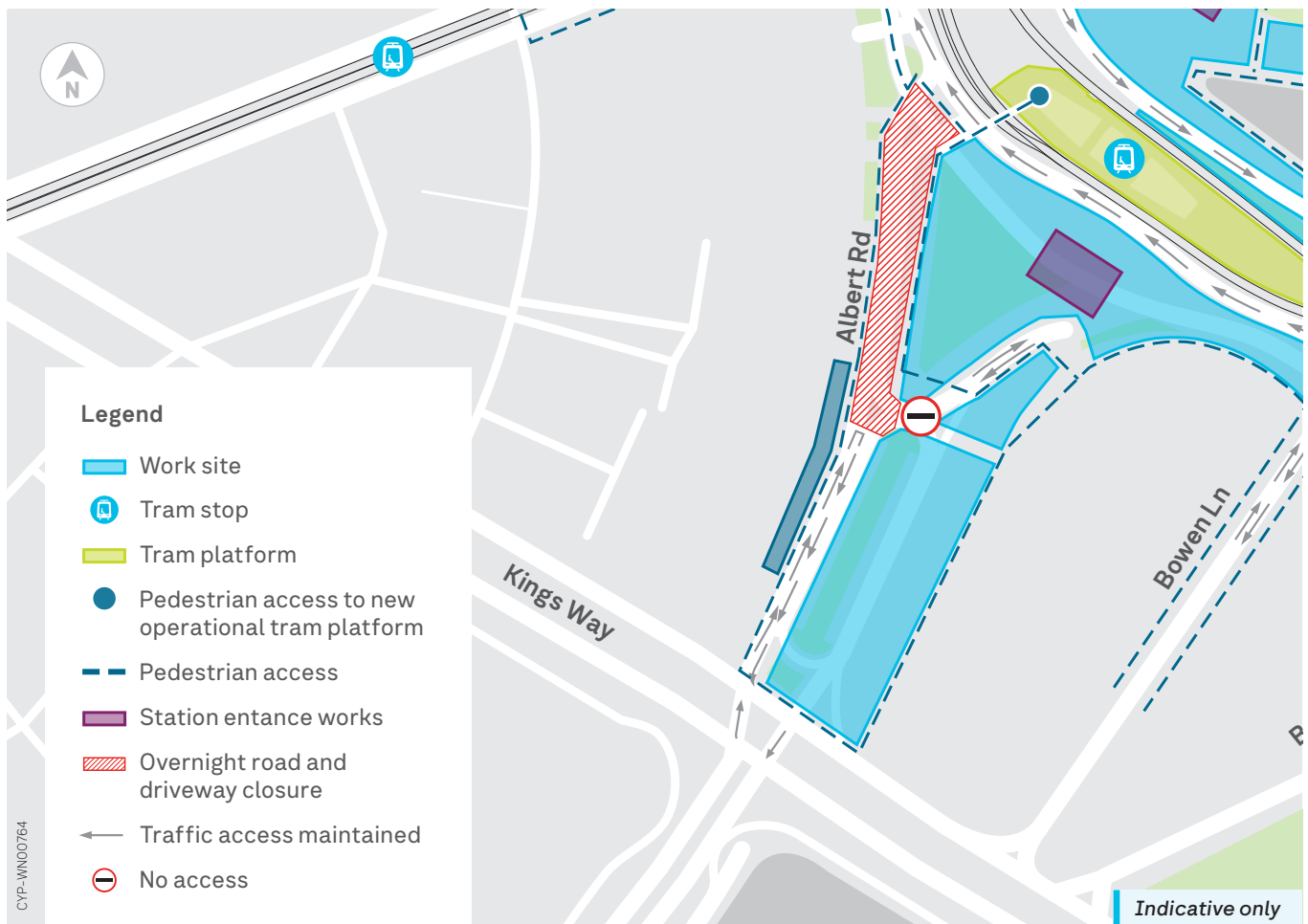
