





Ringwood level crossing removal works

Getting around Bedford Road

The level crossing at Bedford Road, Ringwood will be gone for good in 2024 – a year ahead of schedule.

Works to build the new rail trench under Bedford Road will ramp up from 30 January, and there will be changes to the way you travel.

Removing the Bedford Road level crossing will make the Belgrave Line level crossing free between Ferntree Gully and the city.

Works

Tuesday 30 January to April 2024



Pedestrians and cyclists

Pedestrian and cyclist access across the Bedford Road level crossing will be closed from 30 January for approximately two months while we build the rail trench.

Detours to get around the closure will be available via:

- Rosewarne Lane, Ringwood Lake and Maroondah Highway
- Bedford Road, Warrandyte Road, Maroondah Highway, Ringwood Lake Park and Rosewarne Lane
- Heathmont Road, Campbell Street and Bedford Road.

Drivers

Bedford Road

Bedford Road will be closed at the level crossing between Pitt Street and Rosewarne Lane from 30 January for approximately two months while we build the rail trench.

Drivers can detour via Warrandyte Road, Canterbury Road, Dublin Road, Mount Dandenong Road and Maroondah Highway during this time.

Great Ryrie Street and Pitt Street

Access to Great Ryrie Street and Pitt Street will be closed at the Bedford Road intersection.

Resident access for Pitt Street residents will be maintained via Warrandyte Road.

Parking closures

Lena Grove

Both sides of on-street parking removed.

Ford, Best and David streets

On-street parking removed on one side of Ford Street, both sides of Best Street and one side of David Street to enable safe bus detours.


Fremont Street, Tudor Court and Campbell Street On-street parking removed on one side of Fremont Street, Tudor Court and Campbell Street to enable safe bus detours.

Belgrave and Lilydale lines disruptions

Buses will replace trains on sections of the Belgrave and Lilydale lines from Tuesday 30 January to April 2024.


School bus and PTV service changes

Some bus stops and bus routes along Bedford Road and Great Ryrie Street will be impacted by the closure of Bedford Road.

Impacted services include:

PTV Route 679	Will detour via Best Street and Ford Street
PTV Route 380	A shuttle bus will service passengers between Bedford Road and Dublin Road and Ringwood East Station
AM school services:	2558, 2559, 2575, 2577, 3412, 3431 and 2659
PM school services:	2610, 2650, 3432, 2592, 2613, 2565, 2608 and 2607





PTV Route 679

From Tuesday 30 January until April, PTV Route 679 will detour via Best Street and Ford Street while the Great Ryrie Street and Bedford Road intersection is closed.




PTV Route 380

PTV Route 380 will skip several bus stops between the Bedford Road level crossing and Ringwood East Station.

During this time, a **shuttle bus** will take PTV Route 380 passengers between **Bedford Road and Ringwood East Station**.







Ringwood Secondary College school buses

From Tuesday 30 January until April, school buses will drop off Ringwood Secondary College students on the eastern side of the Bedford Road level crossing while Bedford Road is closed.

The temporary bus stop to drop off and pick up students at Ringwood Secondary College will be relocated approximately 250m east of the existing bus stop outside Ringwood Secondary College, near Tooronga Road.


Impacted school bus routes:

AM school services: 2558, 2559, 2575, 2577, 3412, 3431 and 2659

PM school services: 2610, 2650, 3432, 2592, 2613, 2565, 2608

and 2607
