### **Grants and Partnerships**

#### WGNF applications now open

The West Gate Neighbourhood Fund is now accepting applications for the following categories:

- **Partnerships:** projects over \$50,000 up to \$250,000 for infrastructure improvements to local environments, community centres or sport and recreation facilities.
- **Participation equipment grants**: up to \$5,000 to support community participation in local sport, art or recreation activities.
- **Connecting neighbourhood's grants**: up to \$10,000 for a one-off project or activity that aims to improve community connectedness and participation.
- **Celebrating neighbourhood's grants**: up to \$20,000 for festivals, events, and installations that bring local people together.

Applications are invited from incorporated not-for-profit community groups in the Hobsons Bay or Maribyrnong council areas.

Projects should be shovel ready and need to be delivered by 30 June 2025.

Applications close at 3pm on Monday 18 March.




