

# Works notice



## Concrete pump removal

### Little La Trobe Street

From Tuesday 27 February 2024

We wish to advise that works to remove a concrete pump and its associated infrastructure from Little La Trobe Street will take place under a road closure of Little La Trobe Street.



#### When we'll be working

- 7am to 10pm Monday to Saturday
- 24h road closure from 7am Tuesday 27 February for up to three weeks, or until the work is complete except for during the long weekend, when the road will be open (between Saturday 9 March and Tuesday 12 March)

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

#### What we'll be doing

- Closing Little La Trobe Street between Swanston and Elizabeth streets to facilitate concrete pump removal works (see map)
- There will be intermittent closures of the northern and southern footpath on Little La Trobe Street between Baskerville Lane and Elizabeth Street (see map)

- Through access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times via the northern or southern footpath
- These works involve pump disconnection, hoarding removal, pump and gantry removal, asphalt ramp removal, resurfacing and kerb works
- These works involve the use of a mobile crane, trucks, elevated work platform, excavators, hand tools, power tools and rattle guns.
- Intermittent footpath closures will be in place with pedestrian access maintained via the northern or southern footpath (see map)
- The road will remain closed even when works are not taking place, except for during the long weekend where the road will be open from Saturday 9 March until Tuesday 12 March
- When the road is open, motorist access to Little La Trobe Street will be maintained via Swanston Street only

#### What to be aware of

- The works are expected to take up to three weeks to complete
- During the works, motorist access to Little La Trobe Street and Literature Lane will be maintained via Elizabeth Street southbound (see map)
- Local vehicle access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times under traffic control
- Traffic management will assist pedestrians requiring access to the Aurora building during closures of the southern footpath (see map)
- There will be no through access to Little La Trobe Street from Swanston Street for motorists
- Please allow additional travel time during these works
- A further road closure of Little La Trobe Street is expected to begin in late-March, with pedestrian access maintained. More information will be provided closer to the time.
- Some of these works will generate high levels of noise. Please contact the project team if you have any concerns.

#### Where

- Little La Trobe Street, between Elizabeth and Swanston streets.

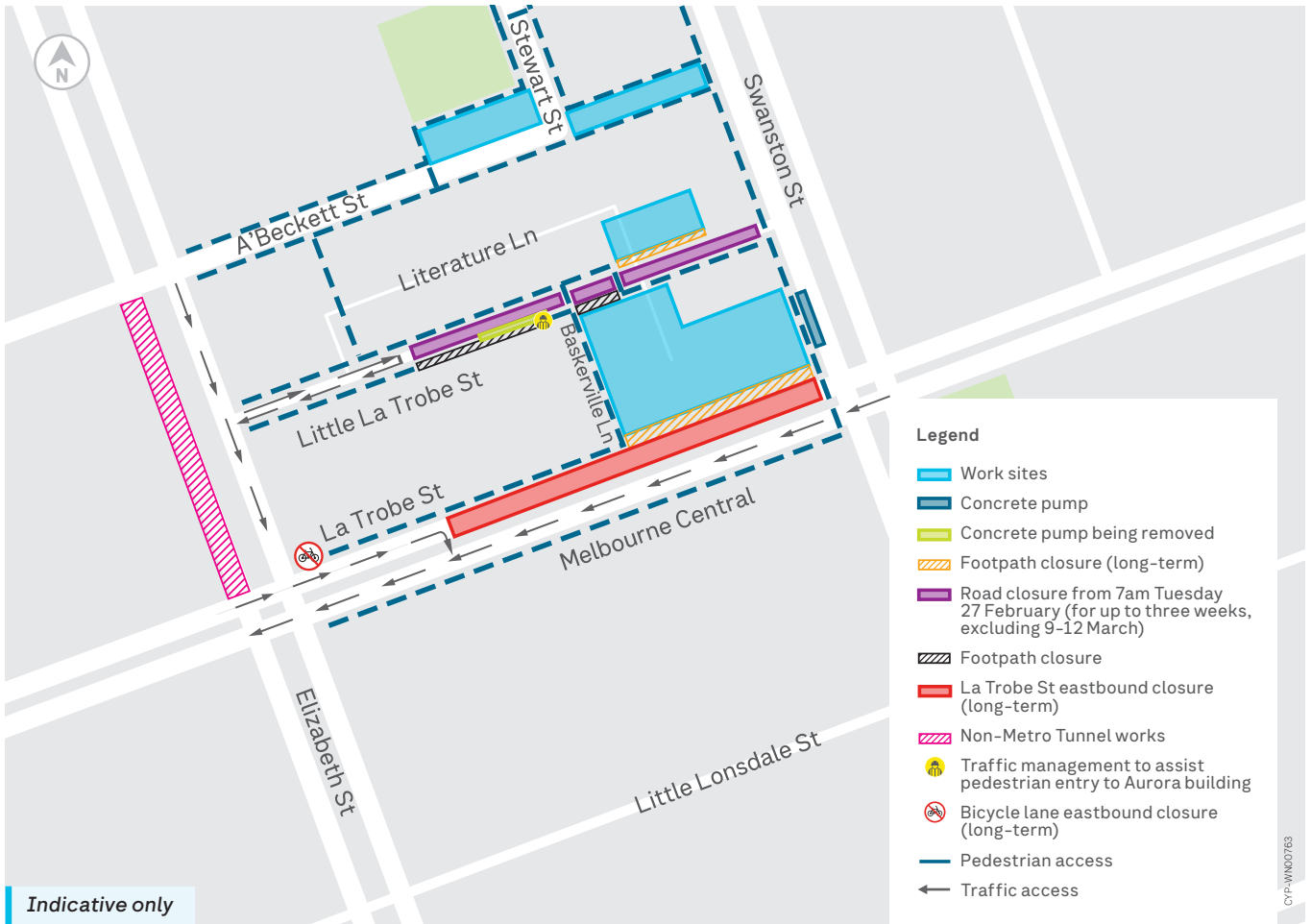
