Paver renewal works requiring Flinders Street footpath closure

Flinders Street, Melbourne

1 October to mid-October 2024

Due to paver renewal works, the southern Flinders Street footpath will be closed in two stages until mid-October.



When we'll be working

- From 1 October to mid-October 2024
- These works will take place
 24 hours a day, Monday to
 Friday.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Establishing a site on the southern Flinders Street footpath, directly adjacent to the Flinders Street Station myki gates opposite Degraves Street, using temporary fencing and bollards
- Removing existing bluestone pavers along the southern Flinders Street footpath, pouring a new concrete slab, placing crushed rock, and installing new pavers
- Works will involve the use of a small excavator, forklift, bin and small truck.

What to be aware of

- The southern Flinders Street footpath will be closed in two stages, directly adjacent to Flinders Street Station (see maps for locations of these staged closures)
- The stage one footpath closure will be in place from 1 October for approx. one week
- Once complete, the stage two footpath closure will be in place for approx. one week
- The staged footpath closures will be in place 24 hours a day until works are complete

- A pedestrian detour will be in place via the northern Flinders Street footpath and existing Flinders Street pedestrian crossings
- Access to local businesses and buildings will be maintained by traffic control during opening hours
- Access to the myki gates adjacent to these works will be maintained at all times. During stage one, access will be maintained from the east side of the gates, and during stage two access will be maintained from the west side of the gates (refer to maps)
- Traffic management and wayfinding will be in place to manage the closure
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise, with intermittent periods of highlevel noise associated with paver removal.


