



Works notification

Marshalltown Road night closure

December 2024

Major construction on the South Geelong to Wearn Ponds Duplication is complete, with two dangerous level crossings removed and the rebuild of two stations for passengers on Victoria's busiest regional rail line.

Marshalltown Road will be closed to traffic at the bus loop intersection for one night from **10pm on Wednesday 18 December until 6am Thursday 19 December 2024** to complete line marking.

What we're doing

A full road closure is required at night on Marshalltown Road at the bus loop intersection, commencing 10pm **Wednesday 18 December 2024**. The bus loop closure works will continue until **Thursday 19 December**.

What to expect

Vehicles will be unable to drive over the level crossing during the night of **Wednesday 18 December 2024**.

Detours will be in place overnight for vehicles with traffic management in place for the safety of workers and the public. Please view the detour map on page 2.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times across the level crossing, and between the temporary bus stops on Marshalltown Road and the station.

Please follow directional signage in place for the location of bus stops and safe entry and exit points to the station precinct.

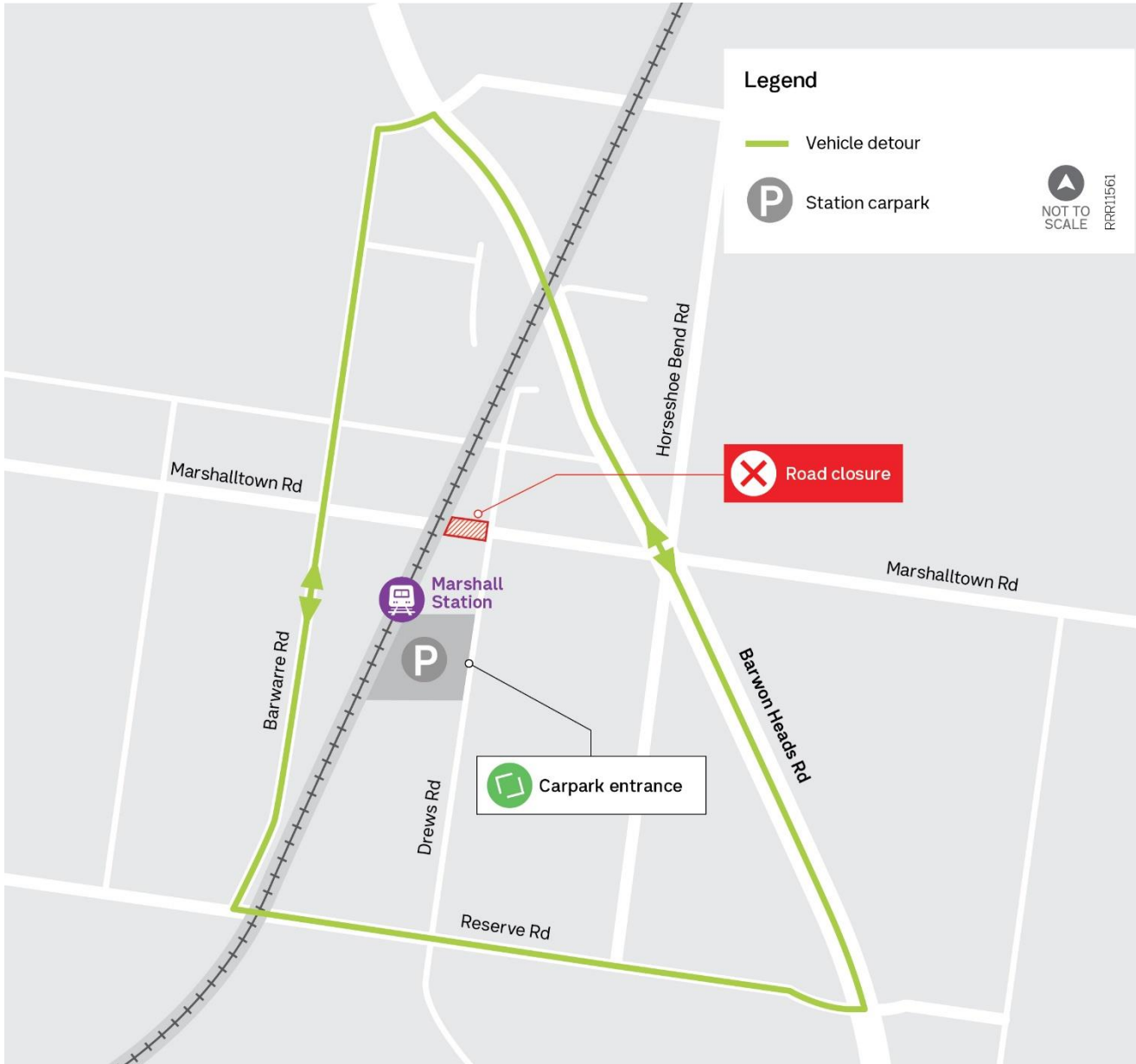
