VICTORIA'S BIG BUILD

As previously notified, several trees have been identified for removal to facilitate rail access construction works.



When we'll be working

We'll be working between
7am to 6pm on Wednesday
28 January 2026.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

As previously notified in the June/July 2025 construction update, trees will be removed to facilitate the new rail access point. One tree

was removed in July 2025. A further seven trees will be removed in January 2026.

The trees are located in the road reserve on the southern side of Childers Street between Ormond Street and Tennyson Street.

This work will involve the use of a non-destructive digging machine (NDD), chainsaw and wood grinder. These activities are expected to generate low levels of noise with intermittent medium levels of noise.

Every effort has been made to minimise tree removal. All trees for removal have undergone a detailed arborist assessment. All areas will be inspected for the presence of any wildlife before works commence.

Childers Street will be managed via shuttle flow arrangement for the works with traffic management in place to assist.
