

Upcoming day/night works for North East Link

Water main construction works at Carron Street, North Balwyn and Estelle Street, Bulleen

Works continue until **late 2021** as we relocate two water mains to make way for the North East Link. This involves using a micro Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) to bore under the Eastern Freeway from Carron Street, Balwyn North, to Estelle Street, Bulleen.

What we're doing

Works include:

- Construction of a laydown area at Estelle Street.
- Installation of site fencing, traffic barriers and site amenities at Estelle Street
- Construction of launch and retrieval shafts using heavy machinery such as excavators, concrete mixers and tip trucks for soil removal
- Boring works underneath the freeway using a micro Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) to install the new water pipes
- Trenching works for pipe laying near Carron Street and across Estelle Street
- Reinstatement works including asphaltting and landscaping after construction.

When we're working

Works will continue at Carron Street and Estelle Street until **late 2021**.

Work hours will increase to 24 hour operations, **7pm** Sunday until **6pm** Saturday, from **Tuesday 6 July** until the **end of August**.

Estelle Street closure

Estelle Street will be closed to traffic between Sefton Street and Kenneth Street from **Wednesday 7 July** until **Friday 6 August**. Access will be maintained to all properties.

What to expect

During works you may notice:

- Work crews in the area
- Light
- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Daytime truck movements with deliveries of materials and construction equipment
- Traffic management in the area
- Vehicle and pedestrian detours will be in place around Estelle Street to safely divert users around the works. Please refer to the map on the back page for more details.

Managing impacts

CPB Contractors are committed to minimising construction impacts for residents and the community and will implement the following mitigation measures where appropriate:

- Noise control equipment and sound blankets may be used on machinery and tools
- Tree protection zones to ensure works do not impact surrounding vegetation
- Access to the Koonung Creek Trail will be maintained where safe to do so.

Our community engagement team will be onsite and available to assist residents during the works.

Safety is our priority and we ask for your assistance with obeying instructions and signage.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.
