

Works Notification

Out of hours works within the rail corridor Between South Yarra and Caulfield stations

October to November 2021

Further to the 24-hour rail works within the rail corridor in October and November, out of hours activity will take place to install signalling cables between South Yarra and Caulfield stations from 9pm until the first passenger train.

What we are doing

- Installing signalling cables within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations
- Works will involve a cable truck and crews with hand tools.

When

- Nightly, 9pm to 5am from Sunday 31 October to Friday 5 November
- Nightly, 9pm to 5am from Sunday 7 November to Friday 12 November.

What you should be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low levels of noise
- Additional truck movements will be required during this time. Materials will be delivered to the rail access points at Chambers Street, Hopetoun Grove, Railway Place, Oban Place, Canterbury Road, Palfreyman Street, Normanby Road, Morey Street, Edward Street, Malvern Woodyard and the vacant land near Malvern station
- Generator-powered lighting towers may be required while we complete these works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators
- For the safety of rail users and our workers, these activities can only be performed when trains are not running
- In mid-November, we will undertake 24-hour rail works across three weekends within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations. Detailed information on these works will be provided closer to the date.



Health and safety

Works safely resumed from 5 October on the Metro Tunnel with COVID-Safe Plans in place to help protect workers and the community.

Strict processes are in place to check and record the vaccination status of workers entering construction sites.
