Construction Update: Rail and Tunnel Fit Out

Rail and track

- Floating slab track (FST) installation continues between State Library and Town Hall stations
- Preparations are underway to install the final section of FST near the Eastern Portal
- The first lengths of rail have been transferred from the Western Portal to cross passage 12 in preparation for installation
- Transfer involved the placement of rail lengths onto a set of skates before pulling them through the tunnel
- Installation will involve the placement of track form units and then threading the rail lengths onto the rail seats to achieve final alignment
- Once the track form and rail are in their final alignment, second stage concrete will be poured. Second stage concrete will bond the track form to the first stage concrete

Platform screen doors (PSDs)

- PSD framework installation is complete at Parkville Station
- PSD framework installation is ongoing at Arden Station
- The first automated door is due to be installed at Parkville in late November.



Construction Update: Project-wide

State Library Station



- Shaft construction is continuing at all five State Library Station sites
- Rail platform tunnel construction is continuing beneath Swanston Street, including the commencement of floating slab track installation
- Station entrance works are continuing with construction of core walls and columns
- The arch pours were recently completed in the Little La Trobe adit
- Melbourne Central escalator installation works are underway.

Town Hall Station



- Hoardings have been installed at platform level and excavation has commenced at Flinders Street Station in preparation for the installation of six lifts from platform level to subway
- Acoustic shed removal works are well underway at City Square
- Concrete structure works continue at City
 Square and Flinders Quarter
- Lining and structures works continue within the station cavern, rail platform tunnels and adits.





Anzac Station



- Works on the canopy over the new tram/train interchange are nearly complete
- Platform precast installation is now complete
- Excavation is now underway on the second stage of the entrance adjacent to the Shrine of Remembrance
- The southbound lane of St Kilda Road has been realigned and works are underway inside site to build the new tram alignment around the tram platform
- Reminder: buses will replace trams on St Kilda
 Road between the Arts Centre and Commercial
 Road from 27 November until 17 December


Glazing installation around the void

Cockatoo lighting brackets

- Two Arden Station skylights have been installed and glazed
- Installation of glass balustrades around the mezzanine perimeters of the central voids is nearly complete
- Installation of architectural features including cockatoo lighting brackets in the station entrance building and in the central atrium void has commenced
- Concourse paving has commenced and will continue over the coming weeks

East building entrance






- Fit off works for vertical transportation, lifts and escalators is ongoing
- Over the coming weeks, protective glazing will be installed on either side of the escalators
- Testing and commissioning will take place in December

Platform






- Installation of acoustic ceiling features,
 ribs and baffles continues at platform level
- Installation of baseplate supports has commenced for the platform screen doors (PSD)
- Over the coming weeks, frames will be installed along the platform to support the PSDs
- Brackets will begin to be installed for CCTV cameras above the PSDs
- Floating track slab installation continues within the tunnels

Surface works





- On surface level, works around the station entrance building continue to form the station's terrace
- StrataVaults have been installed on the northern and eastern sides of the station entrance
- On the southern side of Barwise Street, trenching and subsurface drainage works have commenced. These will form part of the legacy design landscaping
- In 2023 works will commence on the legacy footpath and kerb works in Laurens Street



Current site set-up









Aboveground structures – Grattan Street East

Surface works

- Grattan Street main entrance works are ongoing until early 2023
- Royal Parade entrance steel canopy works to commence in December 2022. Precast elements are being installed
 - Installing the entrance will require setting up scaffolding above the north-east pedestrian footpath
- The ancillary building has been installed
- The goods lift structure will be installed in 2023, following the completion of excavation, permanent structure works etc.
- North-east emergency exit area aboveground structures will start being installed in late November.

Oversized elements will need to be delivered out of hours to comply with Department of Transport requirements.

- Structural works for four out of the six skylights are complete
- The remaining two skylights will be completed by early December

Capping beam and pedestrian gantry removal works – Grattan Street East Surface works

Berkeley to Barry Street

- Ongoing until 19 November
- Footpath closures are in place
- Pedestrian gantry removed
- 50 metres of 80 metres has been removed

Elizabeth to Berkeley streets

- Staged footpath closure to commence 15 November until early 2023
- Pedestrian gantry and capping beam to be removed once the footpath is closed

Working hours are 24 hours, Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.




Capping beam removal – Elizabeth to Berkeley streets Stage 1 Surface works






Capping beam removal – Elizabeth to Barry streets Stage 2 Surface works






MEP and Fit Out Works Station box (including the Royal Parade underpass)



- Fit out works are ongoing in the main box and involve the installation of blockwork walls and mechanical, electrical and plumbing (MEP) systems and architectural features (e.g. cladding)
- Preparation for HV commissioning is underway
- B3 level: architectural fit out is underway for back of house facilities
- B4 level: architectural fit out (e.g. cladding, feature ceilings, flooring) is underway
 - Platform screen doors (PSD) are also being installed

Royal Parade entrance

- Station entrance canopy installation from December
- Fit out works underway

Northeast emergency exit area

- Primary structure works for the upstand walls are ongoing
- Fit out works are ongoing belowground


Retail area

• Structure works are ongoing. Following the completion, fit out works (including blockwork wall construction) will commence.

Goods lift

- Excavation and associated works are ongoing until late January 2023. Following this, structure works will commence
- Excavation and associated works may occur out of hours.

- Architectural and services fit out works are underway



Northern footpath closure

- Until early December, the northern footpath will remain closed to facilitate:
 - Pile deheading
 - Backfilling
 - Removal of the ambulance bridge
 - Escalator entrance construction next to the Royal Melbourne Hospital





Escalator and lift entrances

Aboveground

Escalator entrance (Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre)

- Structure works are ongoing
- Precast panel, escalator and steel canopy installation will commence from 21 November for up to three weeks
- The Grattan Street ambulance lane width will be reduced

Lift entrance (Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre)

• The lift contractor is currently installing the lift

Escalator entrance (Royal Melbourne Hospital)

• Precast panel, escalator and steel canopy installation is underway and will be completed by early December

Lift entrance (Royal Melbourne Hospital)

• Precast panels are installed

Escalator entrance elements are oversized and will be delivered on nightshift







Stage 6A – Grattan Street between Leicester and Bouverie streets (north)



Reinstatement and public realm works

- Timing: October 2022 February 2023
- The work area includes:
 - Grattan Street northern footpath
 - Grattan Street eastbound lane
- Traffic and pedestrian changes:
 - Localised pedestrian diversions e.g.
 - North-south crossing will remain open (location may change)
 - Northern footpath will be closed
 - Eastbound traffic on Grattan Street will remain
- Following completion of these works, Stage 6B legacy works will commence (Grattan Street southern footpath)



Reinstatement and public realm works

- Timing:
 - 1D: late November– January 2023
 - 1G: early December February 2023
- The work area will include:
 - Grattan Street West site
 - Royal Parade northbound service lane between Grattan Street and the RMH stroke ambulance driveway
 - Royal Parade footpath
- Traffic and pedestrian changes:
 - Localised pedestrian diversions
 - Closure of the Royal Parade northbound service lane.
 Vehicles and cyclists will be directed into the inner lane
 - Access to the RMH car park will be maintained from the Royal Parade northbound inner lane
 - Ambulance access will be maintained at all times with minor changes.





Stage 2E – Royal Parade northbound service lane

Reinstatement and public realm works



- Timing: January 2022 February 2023
- The work area will include:
 - Royal Parade northbound service lane between the RMH stroke ambulance driveway and Story Street
- Traffic and pedestrian changes:
 - Closure of the Royal Parade northbound service lane. Vehicles and cyclists will be directed into the inner lane
 - Ambulance access will be maintained at all times with minor changes
 - There will be changes to how vehicles access The Royal Melbourne Hospital car park on Royal Parade
