

## **Monthly construction update**

### **Domain precinct**

**June 2023** 

Works to construct the Metro Tunnel's Anzac Station are progressing. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area in June.

In June, works will continue on legacy public realm elements including the excavation and relaying of the southern footpath on Albert Road and construction of the inner lane of St Kilda Road southbound.

### **Construction snapshot**

Construction works within the Anzac Station precinct during June 2023 include:

- Construction of the station entry in Albert Road
- Albert Road final alignment construction
- Kerb and footpath works
- Anzac Station eastern entrance internal wall construction
- St Kilda Road median works
- Station roof works and utility connections
- Station construction and fit out
- Rail tunnel fit out.

### When are we working?



### **Normal construction hours**

7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.



### **Out of hours**

Some works are required to take place out of normal construction hours.



#### 24 hours

24 hour works are sometimes required during peak construction activities.







### Works in your area

### Kerb and footpath work

### St Kilda Road, between Park Street and Albert Road

May - July 2023



- Works will continue in June on the bluestone footpath between Park Street and Albert Road. A pedestrian detour will be in place for the duration of these works
- All works will be carried out during standard construction hours
- Pedestrian access, including access to the Hallmark Building and Domain Hill apartments, will be maintained during these works.

### Station entrance construction - Albert Road Reserve

### Albert Road Reserve and Albert Road

Ongoing - 2024



- Excavation is complete for the new station entrance
- Steel tying, concrete pours and waterproofing for the base slab and internal walls will continue in June
- Demolition of the temporary piles that separate the concourse level of the new station and the new Albert Road Reserve entrance is complete and the station concourse level is fully connected underground.

### **Albert Road construction**

### **Albert Road**

Ongoing - 2024



- Construction will continue in June on the final configuration of Albert Road north. This includes construction of the final design for the drainage, kerb, roadway and separated bike lanes
- In June, works will continue on the construction of the southern footpath of Albert Road. This is a bluestone footpath in the final design
- In June, the southbound left (slow) lane of Kings Way in front of Albert Road will be closed to enable construction of the new kerb line. The westbound lane of Albert Road will be closed from 14 June for four weeks, vehicles will be unable to exit Albert Road via Kings Way during this time and must exit via St Kilda Road. The slip lane exit onto Kings Way will close permanently as part of the final configuration
- All works will be carried out during standard construction hours.

### Station roof works and Bowen Lane utility connections

#### **Domain precinct**

Ongoing - August 2023



- Works are continuing on the 'delayed strip pour' that will complete the connection between the roof and the diaphragm walls (D-walls) of the station. This work is required on the section of the station box that extends from Bowen Crescent to Bowen Lane
- Works in June will involve steel tying, concrete pours and waterproofing works. Once complete, works will commence to install drainage along the top of the station roof

 In June, works will also continue on the final gas, water and electricity connections underneath Bowen Lane.
These works will take place while the closure of Bowen Lane at St Kilda Road is in place.

#### St Kilda Road and Park Street kerb works

### North-west corner of St Kilda Road and Park Street

Ongoing throughout 2023



- From 5 June, works will commence on the final kerb and pedestrian crossing at the north-west corner of Park Street and St Kilda Road, in front of 380 St Kilda Road
- The works will involve the removal of the temporary kerb, re-asphalting of the footpath and construction of the final kerb outstand
- These works are expected to take four weeks to complete and will require a number of traffic and pedestrian changes in the area. See 'Traffic and Transport' section for further details on traffic changes
- There will be some overnight works while the new traffic configuration is put in place
- A separate construction notice has been distributed with more detail on these works
- At the completion of these works, parking will be returned in both the outer and inner carriageway.

### St Kilda Road median works - South

### St Kilda Road, between Bowen Crescent and Toorak Road

Ongoing throughout 2023



- Construction on the inner southbound carriageway of St Kilda Road will continue in June
- The first stage of permanent parking removal on St Kilda Road, between Bromby Street and Toorak Road, has commenced. The second stage will occur in July. Further detail will be provided closer to the date
- In June, one tree will also be removed in the median in front of the Royce Hotel
- Works will commence in August on the new separated bike lanes on the northbound lane of St Kilda Road, between Toorak Road and Bowen Crescent. This will require the permanent removal of parking along this section of St Kilda Road. Further advice will be provided closer to the date.

### Station entrance construction - Shrine of Remembrance

### **Domain Road**

Ongoing



- Works have commenced on the steel fixing for the internal walls for the station entrance, which will continue through June
- $-\,$  Works under the station roof will continue overnight.

### Station box construction and fit out

### Concourse and platform level of station box

Ongoing



- Commissioning of the lifts and elevators is underway in June. Overnight works are also taking place to test the newly installed platform screen doors
- $\,-\,$  Flooring installation and wall painting continue in June
- Mechanical, electrical and plumbing works continue in the southern and northern ends of the station box
- Plant and HV equipment continue to be installed in back-of-house rooms
- Work will continue on the installation of architectural features and lighting on both the platform and concourse levels
- Precast elements for the platform, exhaust ductwork and station fit out will continue to be delivered and lowered into the station box from 7am until 10pm weekdays, and from 7am until 6pm on Saturdays, using the crane near Domain Road.

### **Traffic and transport impacts**

#### **Oversized deliveries**

— While most deliveries to the Anzac Station site will occur during normal hours, some deliveries to and from site that are classified as 'oversized' will be required outside of normal working hours and overnight. Whenever oversized deliveries are expected overnight, crews will be reminded of noise requirements on site.

#### St Kilda Road median - North

- St Kilda Road traffic will remain in the inner carriageway between Park and Dorcas Streets in June
- Kerbside parking on the outer northbound carriageway is temporarily closed in this section to facilitate the construction of the separated bike lanes, which is expected to take nine weeks to complete.

### North-west corner of St Kilda Road and Park Street

- From 5 June, works will commence on the northwest corner of St Kilda Road and Park Street in front of 380 St Kilda Road
- This will require the closure of Park Street eastbound. During this closure, access to the outer carriageway (service lane) will be via a temporary two-way arrangement from Dorcas Street
- Egress from the service lane will be limited to a left turn onto Dorcas Street
- City bound bicycle traffic will be diverted into the inner carriageway
- The pedestrian crossing over Park Street will again be closed during these works, with pedestrians detoured to cross Park Street at the Wells Street intersection
- The pedestrian crossing over St Kilda Road at Park Street will also be closed during these works, with the nearest crossing point at Dorcas Street
- These changes are expected to be in place for four weeks.

#### St Kilda Road median - South

- The right turn from St Kilda Road onto Kings Way remains closed
- The first stage of permanent parking removal on the southbound lane of St Kilda Road, between Bromby Street and Toorak Road, has come into effect, with the second stage occurring in July
- There will be some changes to the St Kilda Road pedestrian crossing at Toorak Road to complete works in this section. Traffic controllers will be in place while any detours are in effect.

#### **Albert Road construction**

- Parking on the southern side of Albert Road has been permanently removed. Two accessible spaces and a short term drop off bay remain open
- Pedestrians on the southern footpath have been detoured onto a temporary footpath on the roadway while the footpath is rebuilt with bluestone pavers. Access to buildings will be maintained.

#### **Park Street to Albert Road**

 A temporary pedestrian detour will remain in place while footpath works are underway in this section, access to buildings will be maintained.


#### **D-wall demolition at Bowen Lane**

 In May, works commenced to complete the station roof at the intersection of Bowen Lane and St Kilda Road. This requires a closure of Bowen Lane for up to three months. Pedestrian access is maintained.

### Kings Way - left (slow) lane closure


- The southbound left (slow) lane of Kings Way in front of Albert Road will be closed for five weeks to enable construction of the new kerb line
- The westbound lane of Albert Road onto Kings Way will be closed from 14 June for four weeks, vehicles will be unable to exit Albert Road via Kings Way during this time and must exit via St Kilda Road
- The slip lane exit onto Kings Way will close permanently as part of the final configuration
- Traffic signage will be in place ahead of the closure.
