Planning is underway for the Point Cook Road and Central Avenue Intersection Upgrade in Altona Meadows.

We're undertaking planning and development work on behalf of the Victorian Government to investigate options for an upgrade of the Point Cook Road and Central Avenue intersection.

We're also investigating a potential upgrade to Central Avenue, between Point Cook Road and Skehan Boulevard.

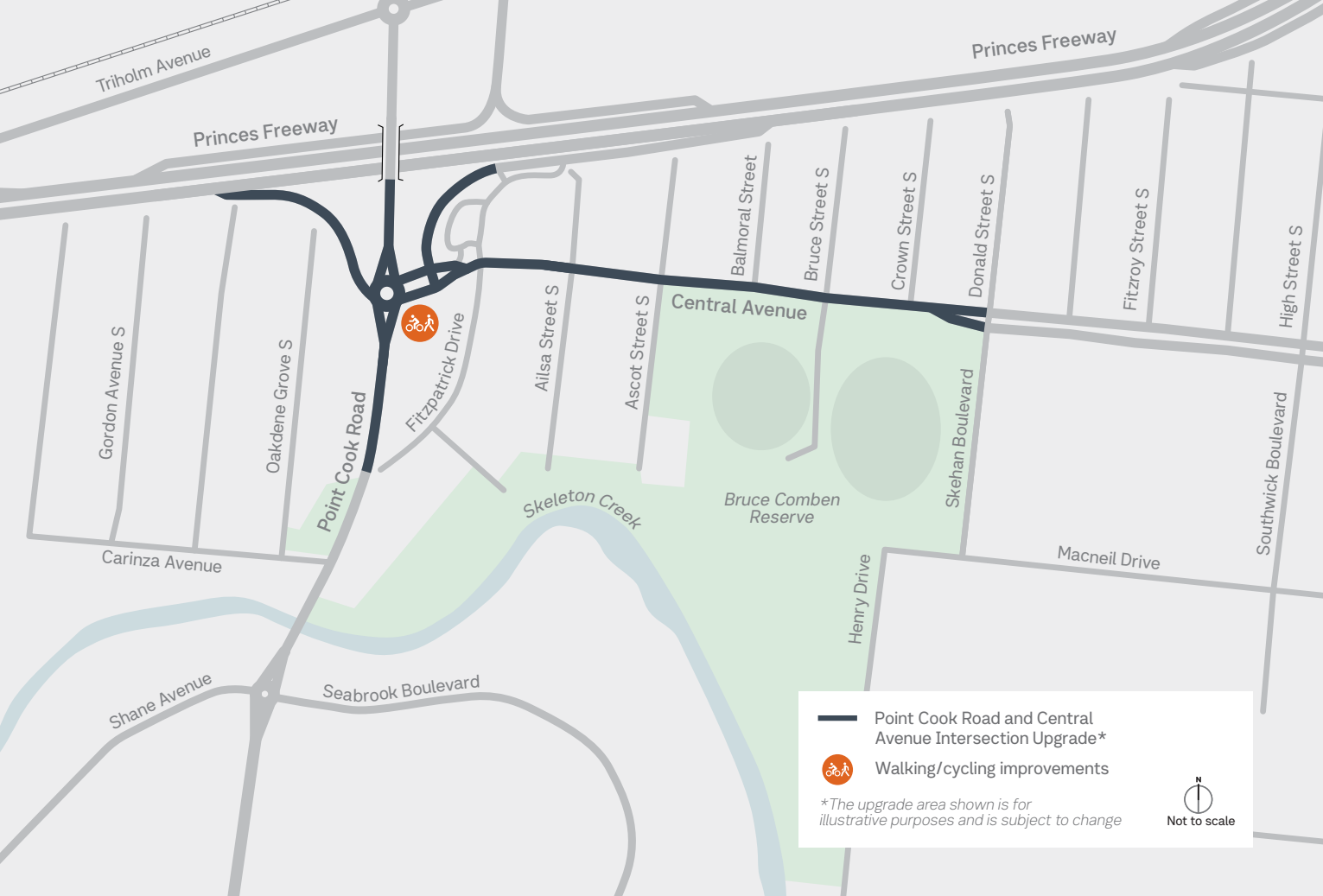
Benefits

Status

We're currently developing a business case and our planning work is expected to be complete in mid-2024.

The business case is a comprehensive document that will provide a detailed examination of the intersection upgrade to help inform government decision-making.

To help inform the business case we're undertaking traffic modelling, constructability assessments, economic modelling, community consultation and environmental investigations. This work will allow us to understand environmental and social impacts, develop design options and confirm scope and costs of different options.

Our planning will build on the previous development work completed by VicRoads.

We will be reviewing technical studies and designs previously developed and will be using these to inform our planning.

We're also considering any recent changes in the area, including population growth.

Roadside technical investigations

To help inform our planning, we will need to undertake roadside technical investigations. At times during these investigations, we may need to implement traffic control measures, including temporary lane closures, stop/slow traffic and reduce speeds. We'll keep traffic disruption to a minimum and will avoid busy periods.

Project timeline

- October 2022**
 - Intersection upgrade announced by the Victorian Government
- Early 2023**
 - Planning commenced
- March 2023**
 - Technical investigations commenced, to help us get a better understanding of the local area
 - Community and business consultation
- Mid-2024**
 - Business case complete
