Reinstatement and public realm works

Elizabeth Street, between Grattan and Pelham streets

22 August to mid-September 2023

The Parkville Station precinct has moved into the final phase of construction with reinstatement and public realm works underway.

Throughout the Parkville precinct, staged reinstatement and public realm works are ongoing until early 2024. These works include service relocations, footpath, kerb and road pavement construction, traffic signal modifications, and installation of bus stops, street furniture, lighting and landscaping.

Reinstatement and public realm works will take place up to property boundaries, including on footpaths and directly adjacent to building entrances. There will be changes to the way you move around the precinct during these works.

On 22 August, reinstatement and public realm works will commence in the Elizabeth Street southbound service lane and adjacent footpath, between Grattan and Pelham streets.

What we are doing

- Site establishment including installing water barriers, bollards and signage around the perimeter of the work site
- Removing sections of the eastern Elizabeth Street footpath, between Grattan and Pelham streets, which involves non-destructive digging, excavating and saw cutting
- Accessing and installing underground services and utilities in the Elizabeth Street southbound service lane, between Grattan Street and Haymarket Roundabout
- Asphaltting the permanent eastern Elizabeth Street footpath, between Grattan and Pelham streets.

What to be aware of

- The eastern Elizabeth Street footpath, between Grattan and Pelham streets, will be closed for up to a week during these works
- The footpath will remain closed outside of working hours
- A pedestrian diversion will be in place via Haymarket Walk, Berkeley Street and Pelham Street
- The Elizabeth Street pedestrian crossing at Pelham Street will remain open
- Access to the #9 Pelham Street/Elizabeth Street tram stop will be maintained
- Pedestrian access to all local buildings and businesses will be maintained
- The southbound service lane will remain closed during these works
- Access to the Doherty Institute loading bays on Elizabeth Street will be maintained
- Vehicles and cyclists will remain diverted into the inner Elizabeth Street southbound lane during these works
- Traffic management measures will be in place during all closures and diversions
- These works are expected to take place during normal working hours only
- Stakeholders will be notified separately prior to any out-of-hours works, if required
- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise.

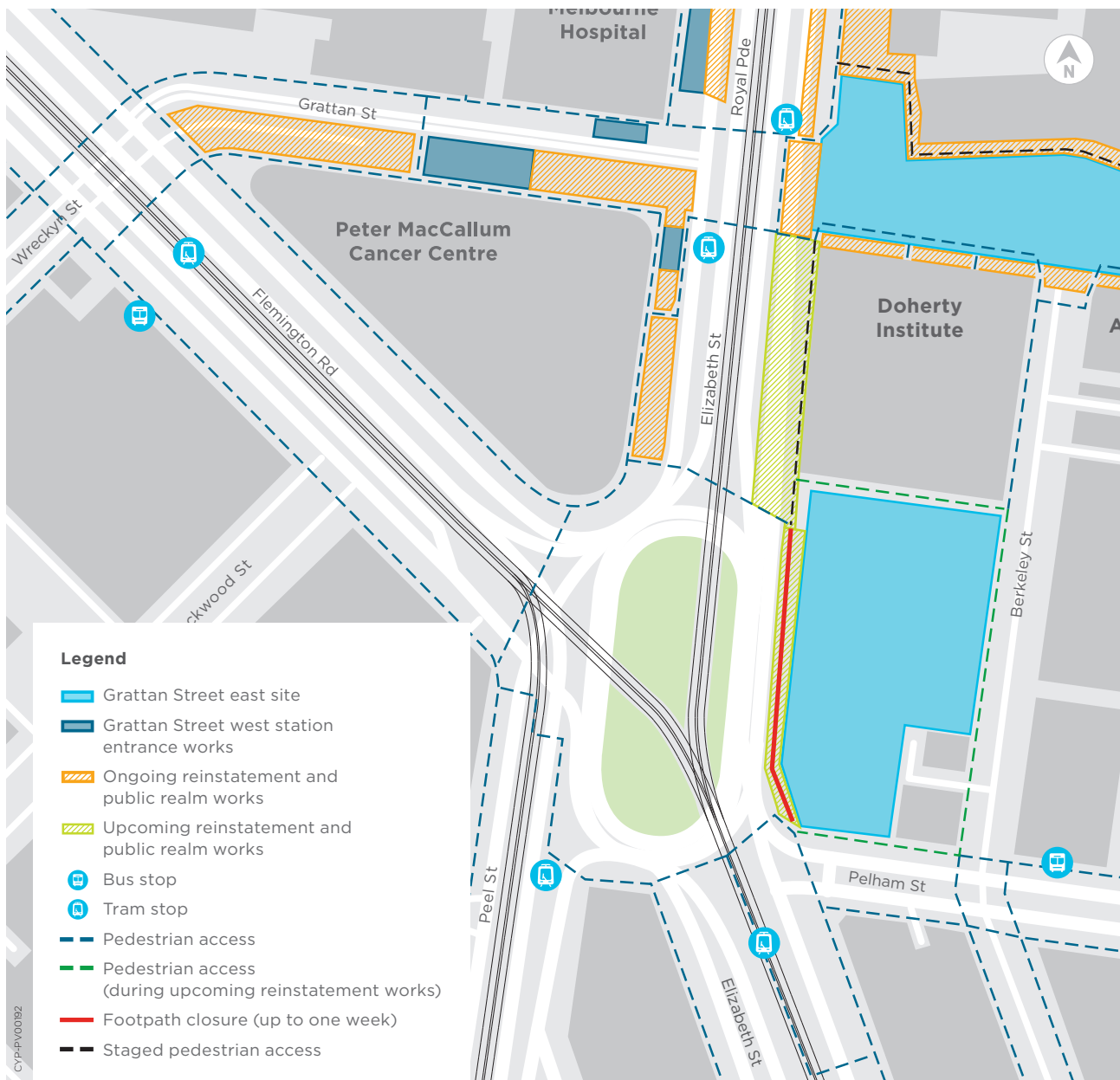
