Pedestrian crossing pole installation

Laurens Street, North Melbourne

Wednesday 20 September 2023

On Wednesday 20 September, there will be a one day road closure on Laurens Street, between Barwise and Queensberry streets, to enable the installation of pedestrian signal infrastructure as part of public realm works.

What we are doing

- Installing poles on Laurens Street that will support a future signalised pedestrian crossing.

What to be aware of

- To safely install pedestrian signal infrastructure, **Laurens Street will close to vehicles and cyclists between Barwise and Queensberry streets on Wednesday 20 September from 7am to 6pm**
- During the one day road closure, vehicles will be detoured via Dryburgh Street and cyclists will be detoured via Munster Terrace or Dryburgh Street
- The western footpath on Laurens Street between Arden and Queensberry streets will remain closed and a pedestrian detour to the eastern footpath will be in place
- Local access to properties will be maintained at all times
- These works are expected to generate periods of low to medium level noise
- These works are expected to take place during normal working hours only.

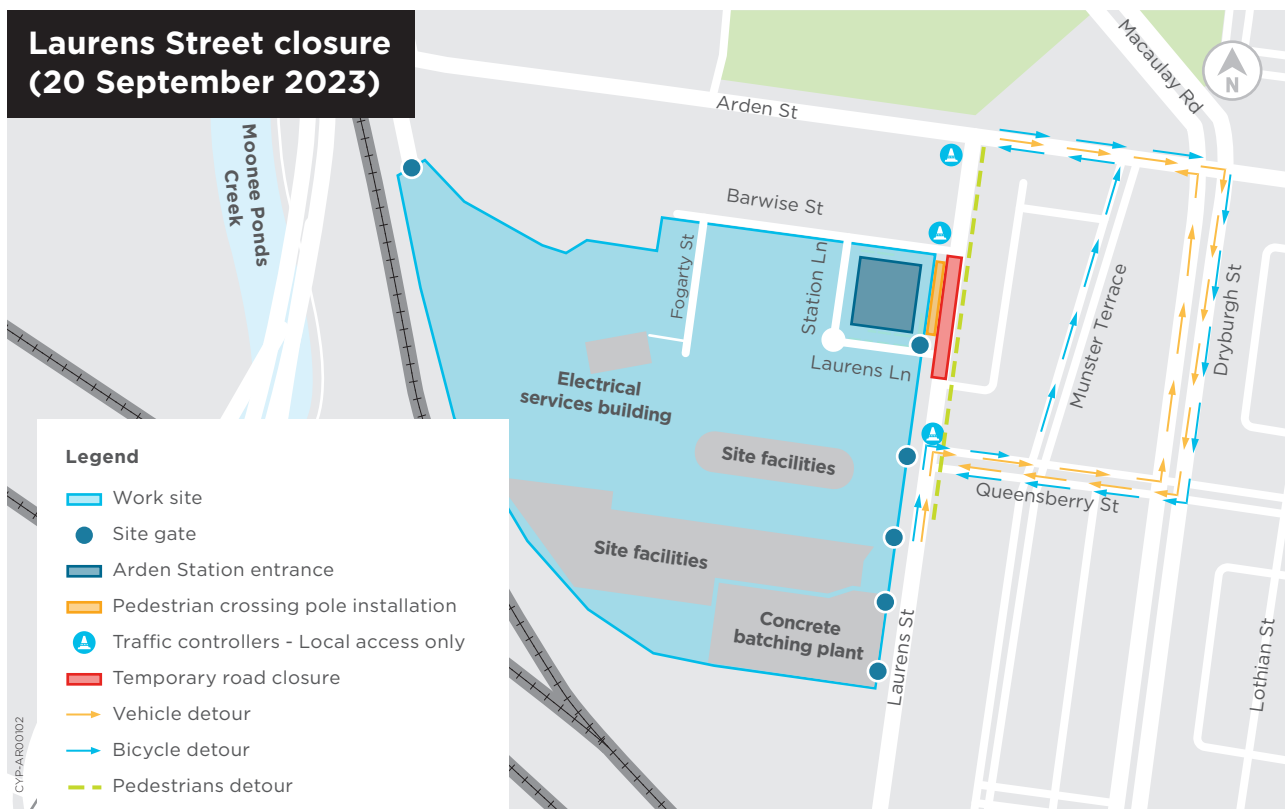
