Footpath resurfacing

St Kilda Road

From Monday 15 January 2024 to Monday 5 February 2024

As part of the finishing works for the Metro Tunnel Project in the Anzac precinct, the footpath in front of 400 St Kilda Road will be re-laid with new asphalt.



When we'll be working

 Works will commence on Monday 15 January and are expected to be completed by Monday 5 February 2024. To complete these works, pedestrian diversions are required in front of 400 St Kilda Road. Access will be maintained at all times, with pedestrians diverted around the works area.

What we'll be doing

- Diverting pedestrians via a temporary path along the recently completed bike lane on St Kilda Road
- Establishing temporary pedestrian connections into 400 St Kilda Road
- Breaking out the existing footpath and laying new asphalt up to the building line
- Maintaining access to buildings at all times while we work, Monday 15 January to Monday 5 February 2024

What to be aware of

- These works will be done in stages to maintain building access.
 Please expect some changes to signage and pedestrian movements during this time
- These works are expected to generate periods of medium levels of noise associated with the removal of the existing asphalt.




