What we'll be doing

- High capacity train testing between Caulfield and Westall stations
- Signalling software upgrades.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low levels of noise
- To ensure the systems integrity of the new high capacity trains as well as the safety of passengers, some activities can only be performed while train services are not running. Bus replacements will operate during some of these works.
