Pedestrian crossing removal and paver renewal works

Flinders Street, Melbourne

21 August to late September 2024

Please be advised that the temporary pedestrian crossing located on Flinders Street, between Woolworths Metro and Flinders Street Station, will be permanently removed in late August. Bluestone pavers on the northern and southern sides of Flinders Street will also be renewed.

This temporary crossing has supported pedestrian and traffic movements during Town Hall Station works over the last few years.

These activities form part of works to reinstate community spaces around our work sites, in preparation of the Metro Tunnel opening in 2025.



When we'll be working

- From 21 August to late
 September 2024
- These works will take place 24 hours a day to minimise impacts on pedestrians and businesses.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Removing ramped sections of the temporary pedestrian crossing on the northern and southern sides of Flinders Street (refer to map for location)
- Works will include removing existing pavers, pouring new concrete slab, placement of crushed rock, and relaying of new pavers
- Works will involve the use of a non-destructive digging truck, small excavator, forklift and small truck
- Remaining infrastructure on Flinders Street such as line markings and traffic signals will also be removed, and new linemarking will be completed
- Works will also take place to remove and replace pavers on the northern and southern sides of Flinders Street (see map for location).
- These works will be staged to minimise impacts and footpaths will remain open throughout these works but will be narrowed at times.

What to be aware of

- Work sites on either side of the crossing will be fenced off
- The Flinders Street eastbound lane will be closed between Elizabeth and Swanston streets, from 8pm to 6am on 21 and 22 August
- The Flinders Street westbound lane will be closed between Swanston and Elizabeth streets, from 1am to 5am on 21 and 22 August
- Access for business deliveries and waste collection will be maintained by traffic control
- During paving renewals works crews will work in staged sections which will be fenced off
- The Flinders Street footpath will be narrowed to allow for these works to be undertaken safely. Please follow traffic management and signage in the area
- Multiple crossings nearby are still available for pedestrians to cross Flinders Street (refer to map)
- These works will generate some periods of high noise and medium vibration.


