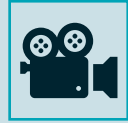

# Northern roundabout works



Crews completed building the roundabout at the intersection of Station Street, Beaconsfield Avenue and Goff Street, and asphaltting in the northern car park.





# Beam lifts complete



In October, the final 37 bridge beams were delivered to site overnight and installed using a 650-tonne crane.



A total of 52 beams have been installed to form the structure of the 427m new road bridge, spanning the rail line and connecting Beaconsfield Avenue to Kenilworth Avenue.



This marks the completion of beam lifts at Beaconsfield.



# Upcoming works this December

- We will continue working south of the rail line to build the new road bridge, now that final beams have been installed.
- During this time, Kenilworth Avenue will be closed as we build a new roundabout at the intersection of Kenilworth Avenue, Soldiers Road and the Beaconsfield Avenue underpass. We'll also continue works on the northern car park.

## What to expect:



- Increased construction activity, noise and vibration
- Temporary road and lane closures
- Reduced speed limits
- Lighting for safe working conditions at night
- Standard work hours **Monday to Friday, 6.30am to 6pm and Saturday 7am to 3pm**, with out of hours works at times.



# Disruptions



## Road closures

Until **Thursday 19 December**:

- Kenilworth Avenue will be closed between Soldiers Road roundabout and Station Street.
- Soldiers Road will be closed in both directions.
- Detour via Bryn Mawr Boulevard, Woods Street and Princes Highway, or Brunt Road and Princes Highway.



## Pedestrian detours

- Pedestrian detours will be in place around the intersection of Beaconsfield Avenue, Kenilworth Avenue and Soldiers Road until **Thursday 19 December**. Please follow signage.



## Bus stop closures

Until **Thursday 19 December**:

- Bus stops along route 836 on Kenilworth Avenue and Soldiers Road, between Station Street and Streeton Way, will be temporarily closed in both directions.
- Alternative bus stops are located at McCubbin Way/Streeton Way and Beaconsfield Avenue/Beaconsfield Station.

## Level crossing removal community update

Beaconsfield's new road bridge taking shape

As part of the Victorian Government's commitment to removing all 22 level crossings on the Pakenham Line by 2025, we're removing the level crossing at Station Street, Beaconsfield.

Major works are continuing to remove the level crossing at Station Street, Beaconsfield and the new road bridge is coming to life. Over the past few months, our crews installed 34 retaining walls and 170 of 52 bridge beams, each weighing up to 65 tonnes.

We'll continue working north and south of the rail line to build the new road bridge. This includes construction and piling works, ground improvement works and building bridge structures.

The boom gates at Station Street, Beaconsfield will be gone for good and the new road bridge open in 2025. Together with the Metro Tunnel, this project will create capacity for an additional 121,000 peak hour passengers every week. It will also give people access to 5 new underground stations in Melbourne's CBD and surrounds.

**Why this level crossing needs to go**

- 25 trains during the morning peak
- 3 near misses and one collision since 2012
- Boom gates down for 28% of the morning peak

## Works notification

### Station Street, Beaconsfield – October works

We're making the Pakenham Line level crossing free by 2025, removing 22 dangerous and congested level crossings.

During October 2024, we'll continue building the new road bridge over the rail line and constructing the new northern car park. Works include ground improvement works, installing power poles in the car park and lifting bridge beams on the south side of the rail line.

All times, we'll work 24 hours a day. Where possible, disruptive works will be scheduled for earlier in the day to minimise impacts to locals. Impacted residents will be notified prior to works commencing.

### Upcoming works

- Between 11.30pm and 4.30am, Sunday 13 October to Thursday 17 October and Thursday 24 October to Saturday 26 October, bridge beams will be delivered to Kenilworth Avenue. Beams will arrive overnight and will be unloaded during the day.
- From Monday 14 October to Saturday 26 October, bridge beams will be lifted and installed south of the rail line using a large crane.
- From 7am to 5pm Tuesday 22 October and Wednesday 23 October, the underpass at Beaconsfield Avenue will be closed in both directions to carry out public lighting works. During this time, there will also be a shuttle flow along Kenilworth Avenue. Please follow signage around the area.

Every effort will be made to complete these works to schedule; however, dates and times are subject to change.

### What to expect

- Increased construction activity, noise, and vibration.
- Temporary lane closures.
- Reduced speed limits.
- Lighting for safe working conditions at night.
- Working hours Monday to Sunday 6am to 6pm, with 24 hour works at times.

Traffic management will be in place for the safety of the community and our workforce. Please follow the signs and instructions when travelling around the project area.

## Construction update



The new road bridge is coming together ahead of its opening to the public in 2025.

### Upcoming works

In November and December, we will continue working south of the rail line to build the new road bridge, now that the final beams have been installed.

During this time, Kenilworth Avenue will be closed as we build a new roundabout at the intersection of Kenilworth Avenue, Soldiers Road and the Beaconsfield Avenue underpass. We'll also continue works on the northern car park.
