

Interpretive artwork

- Shortlisted Artists nominated by the two Registered Aboriginal Parties (RAPs) whose lands we work on, Wurundjeri and Bunurong, submitted concepts for the opportunities as part of the competitive tender process.
- CPBJH JV assembled an Indigenous Co-Design Advisory Panel (the Panel) to evaluate the tender submissions for the four WGTP Indigenous Co-Design opportunities.
- Late last year, four preferred Artists were selected to deliver the opportunities.

Interpretive signage

- The Interpretive artworks package includes interpretive signs across the project corridor to explain aspects of Indigenous and European heritage.
- Indigenous signage will be developed with the artists and RAPs as appropriate to be displayed next to the artworks.
- European signage will be displayed near key heritage locations in accordance with the project's Environmental Performance Requirements and heritage consent conditions. Heritage Victoria will endorse the content.

- Harris Street

 - Council engagement: Worked with Maribyrnong Council to support the changeover of Whitehall Street 'no standing' signs to provide an additional 9 car spaces.



Footscray Road – architectural design




The 'rope' elements introduced on Footscray Road reflect Melbourne's maritime history and the historic shipping tool of a tarred rope.

Using the piers as a 'virtual forest', the orange sculptural rope motif creates a visual link between the piers and barriers and the use of colour helps to animate the journey.
