## Removal of Relocatable Equipment Building

Relocatable Equipment Building (REB) removal requiring the closure of Rayhur Street between First and Third streets.



#### When we'll be working

 These works will take place during the day on Tuesday 16 September between 7am to 6pm

Please note works may be rescheduled due to inclement weather.

#### **REB**

Relocatable Equipment Building (REB)

An REB is a single storey building that houses rail service equipment to help power bigger, more modern trains.

#### What we'll be doing

- We are removing a Relocatable Equipment Building (REB) as it is no longer required for Metro Tunnel Project works
- Setting up a crane on Rayhur Street
- Using hand tools to prepare the REB for removal
- Using the crane to load the REB onto an oversized trailer
- Removal of the crane.

#### What to be aware of

- Rayhur Street will be closed to through traffic and pedestrians between First and Third streets with a detour in place via Tippet Street
- Second Street will be closed to through traffic between Rayhur and Tippet streets with detours in place via First and Third streets
- Pedestrian access along Second Street will be maintained, including the pedestrian rail crossing at Rayhur Street, under the direction of traffic control
- Access to residential properties along Rayhur Street between First and Second streets will be maintained from First Street under the direction of traffic control
- Access to residential properties along Rayhur Street between Second and Third streets will be maintained from Third Street under the direction of traffic control
- These works will produce medium levels of noise.
