Works are underway in Clayton to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

Impacts



How we will manage our works


- Maintaining access for emergency vehicles and buses at all times
- Maintaining access to homes and businesses
- Safely removing hazardous materials in accordance with regulations
- Transporting materials from site in covered trucks to minimise dust
- Using water and dust suppressants
- $-\,$ Installing road safety and detour signage
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours in place.













How are we preparing to excavate the station site?

We are building concrete walls which are called 'diaphragm walls'. These concrete walls are built deep into the ground to form a reinforced structure for the underground station.

These are built by excavating deep into the ground, installing steel cages and pouring concrete to create a solid underground wall.
