Road closure

A'Beckett Street

From 20-24 October

We are re-asphalting A'Beckett Street from Monday 20 to Friday 24 October 2025.



When we'll be working

- 24h from 6pm Monday 20
 October to 7am Friday 24
 October (or until the works are complete)
- There will be no vehicle access to A'Beckett Street during these works

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Closing the road and setting up the work site
- Removing the existing road surface
- Laying asphalt to form the new road surface
- Line marking the new road surface.

What to be aware of

- Road works are required to rebuild A'Beckett Street to its final configuration
- A'Beckett Street will be closed between Elizabeth and Swanston streets from 6pm Monday 20 October to 7am Friday 24 October
- These works include profiling, asphalting and line marking which may produce medium to high levels of noise and some vibrations
- Where possible, noisy works will take place in the daytime
- No vehicles will be able to access
 A'Beckett Street between Elizabeth
 and Swanston streets including for
 deliveries and waste collection
- Please contact the Metro Tunnel Project Team on cyp@metrotunnelcyp-dc.com.au or 1800 105 105 if you are a resident or business owner and require alternative parking during these works

- Cyclists will be required to dismount and use the footpath during these works
- There will be no on street parking available on A'Beckett Street between Elizabeth and Swanston streets during these works
- During these works, pedestrians can only cross A'Beckett Street at the dedicated pedestrian crossing at Elizabeth Street
- Access to buildings in Stewart Street will be maintained via Franklin Street, with a two-way traffic arrangement under the direction of traffic control
- A'Beckett Street will be accessible from Swanston Street upon completion of these works (refer to map)
- Pedestrian access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times.








Traffic arrangement during works
