Albert Road footpath (at St Kilda Road) and Anzac Station Tram Stop

10 to 22 November 2025

Paving works are being completed on the Albert Road pedestrian crossing ramp at St Kilda Road, in front of The Hallmark, and on the Anzac Station Tram Stop. The Albert Road crossing will be closed from 10 to 22 November.



When we'll be working

- 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays
- Monday 10 to Saturday 22
 November 2025

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Removing sections of existing paving at the pedestrian ramp on the corner of Albert Road and St Kilda Road, and on the Anzac Station Tram Stop
- Laying new paving in both locations.

What to be aware of

- The Albert Road pedestrian crossing at St Kilda Road will be closed from 10 to 22 November during these works
- A pedestrian detour will be in place via the southern Albert Road pedestrian crossing
- Cyclist access will be maintained via the Albert Road northbound lane
- A small area on the northern side of the Anzac Station Tram Stop will be behind barriers from 10 to 22 November. Full pedestrian access will be maintained around the tram stop
- Traffic controls and signage will be in place to manage the works.


