	Calocephalus citreus	Lemon Beauty Heads	Melton	FS	0.2-0.5 x 0.3-1.0m	Well drained	Soft yellow (Oct-Feb)	Also good container plant. Flowers dry well
	Brachyscome paludicola	Swamp Daisy/Basalt Daisy	Somerton	FS - PS	0.2-0.5 x 0.3-0.6m	Moist soils	White (Sep-Nov)	Locally rare

	Dichondra repens	Kidney Weed	Wildwood	FS - PS	Prostrate	Well drained soils	Tiny greenish (Sep-Dec)	Prostrate, groundcover sometimes used as an alternative to grass
	Einadia hastata	Berry Saltbush	Wildwood	FS - PS	0.2 x 0.5	Well drained soils	Very small, white followed by tiny red berries	Prune regularly to maintain vigorous growth
	Einadia nutans	Nodding Saltbush	Wildwood	FS - PS	0.3 x 1-2m	Well drained soils	Very small, white followed by tiny red berries	Prune regularly to maintain vigorous growth
	Enchylaena tomentosa	Ruby Saltbush	Wildwood	FS - PS	0.3 x 1-2m	Well drained soils	Very small, white followed by tiny red berries	Prune regularly to maintain vigorous growth

	Eutaxia mcrophylla	Common Eutaxia	Melton	FS - PS	Prostrate	Well drained soils - can tolerate waterlogging once established	Yellow and orange (Aug-Oct)	Decorative. Grows well in containers. Responds well to pruning
	Grevillea rosmarinifolia	Rosemary Grevillea	Somerton	FS - PS	1-3m x 2-3m	Well drained soils	Red (July-Nov)	Prickly leaves. Responds well to pruning. Propagate through cuttings
	Myoporum parvifolium	Creeping Boobialla	Corio	FS	Prostrate x 2-4m	Well drained soils	White (Oct-Nov)	Prune regularly to maintain vigorous growth

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	Olearia ramulosa	Twiggy Daisy Bush	Essendon	FS - PS	0.5-2.5 x 1m	Well drained soils	White (Sep-May)	Prune following flowering to maintain foliage density
	Poa sieberiana	Tussock Grass	Sunshine North	FS	0.3 x 0.4m	Well drained soils	Tall (to 1m) panicles (Oct-Jan)	Attractive tufting grass
