Commissioning signalling works

Works are continuing to upgrade the Maryborough Yard and re-establish a passing loop at Tourello as part of the Murray Basin Rail Project.

What we're doing

24-hour works will take place from **Saturday 25 April to Thursday 21 May**, while coaches replace trains.

Works in Maryborough, Clunes, Tourello and Creswick will include:

- Installing, testing and commissioning new signalling equipment along the rail corridor
- Track works, civil earthworks and signalling construction
- Driver training for the new signalling system

What to be aware of

- Increased construction vehicle movements in the area
- Temporary lighting in some locations, including light towers
- Additional noise and minor dust during construction activities
- Localised traffic management at level crossings for the safety of works crews and road users

How we're minimising impacts

We're working to reduce disruption to the community by:

- Using water carts to manage dust where required
- Positioning lighting away from nearby properties where possible
- Monitoring noise and completing high-impact activities as efficiently as possible

Changes to the way you travel

Coaches will replace trains for all or part of the journey on the Maryborough, Ballarat and Ararat lines between **Saturday 25 April and Thursday 21 May**. Please plan ahead by visiting vline.com.au
