Gantry cranes remove excavated material and load into trucks waiting inside acoustic enclosures (Stage 3)												
Base slab construction commences												








WHAT'S HAPPENING AT GRATTAN ST EAST

14-Mar-19 11:49 AM

- Capping beam 96% completed
- Steel struts
 - Treatment to localised areas of the struts has commenced and is ongoing with struts progressively delivered back to site and installed
- Deck installation
 - Underway at the eastern end of site. Gate 10 access scheduled to reopen end March
 - Deck completed (Stage 1) late April
- Excavation
 - Extended shift for excavation to 10pm commencing Monday 18 March
 - 24 hours electrical works to install lighting under the deck








WHAT'S HAPPENING AT GRATTAN ST EAST

- Deliveries of oversized support beams underway:
 - deliveries need to occur outside of normal construction hours due to VicRoads requirements for oversized deliveries
 - total 34 deliveries over eight nights with up to
 4-5 deliveries per night
 - deliveries will occur between 11pm to 5am via Royal Parade
 - first two deliveries completed. Next scheduled deliveries March 18 & 20.











BEAM AND DECK INSTALLATION













WHAT'S HAPPENING AT GRATTAN ST EAST

Gantry cranes

- progressively delivered to City Ford site from 13 March until approximately May
- 24 hour works required to prepare and commission the gantry cranes
- works will be undertaken both at the City Ford site and at Grattan Street east site
- middle gantry crane scheduled to be installed on site weekend 23 & 24 March
- remaining gantry cranes will continue to be installed over the next six weeks.

Royal Parade

- additional drainage works on the east side of Royal Parade underway
- Saturday 16 March partial closure of the southbound service lane on Royal Parade.







WHAT'S HAPPENING AT GRATTAN ST WEST

Early February

 Service locating – ongoing. Some night works required to complete the service locating on Grattan Street and Royal Parade. Scheduled from 8pm to 5am from Sunday 24 to Monday 25 March

Late March to May

- Service proving involves identifying services located saw cutting; NDD truck; backfill and reinstatement
- Staged lane closures on Grattan Street between Royal Parade and Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street / Royal Parade northbound service lane
- Construction Noise and Vibration Impact Assessment (CNVIA) stakeholder engagement underway

July 2019 – February 2020

Service Relocations (including civil works and connection works)

Mid 2020 - 2022

- Station entrance construction.
- Timing depending on relevant approvals for CNVIA and Traffic Management Plans.

- Ongoing site establishment activities
- Delivery of slurry treatment plant and tunnel boring machine (TBM) parts to site
- Slurry treatment plant and concrete batching plant construction
- Station box excavation and installation of station box frame (steel struts)
- Concreting of internal haulage roads and installation/relocation of rumble grids
- Surveying, and sampling and testing of groundwater and soil
- Modifications to hoarding, fencing and gates
- Short-term lane closures on Laurens Street for utility connections
- Road cleaning on Arden and Laurens streets to minimise the spread of dirt on local roads.







Out of hours works


- 6pm 10pm, Monday to Friday
 - Station box excavation, steel strut welding and installation inside the excavated station box
 - Over-size equipment deliveries to and from site and use of a crawler crane to unload deliveries
 - Base slab construction
- 10pm 7am, Monday to Friday
 - Station box excavation, steel strut welding and installation inside the excavated station box
 - Over-size equipment deliveries to and from site and use of a crawler crane to unload deliveries
 - Road cleaning on Arden Street as required

After 6pm, all construction vehicles will enter and exit via Arden Street wherever possible.







TBM ARRIVAL












TUNNELLING TIMELINE

January 2019 – mid 2019	TBMs arrive Arden and assembled
3rd quarter – 4th quarter 2019	TBM 1&2 — Arden to Western Portal
4 th quarter 2019 – 1 st quarter 2020	TBM 1&2 - transported back to Arden
1st quarter 2020 – mid 2020	TBM 1&2 – Arden to Parkville


PARKVILLE - GRATTAN ST WEST TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Service locating and proving works

- February to March service locating
- March to May service proving
 - Localised staged lane closures on Grattan Street between Royal Parade and Flemington Road
 - Localised staged northbound service lane closure on Elizabeth Street / Royal Parade (from Haymarket Roundabout to north of RMH)
 - Works will be staged to minimise impacts
 - Motorists are advised to plan trips ahead of time.
