PROJECT OVERVIEW










ARDEN

- Services building construction is progressing with preparatory works for the façade panel installation underway
- Seven pre-cast brick arches have now been cast, these will be used to construct the station entrance
- Platform works are taking shape in the west box.








PARKVILLE

- Piling works for the Grattan Street west entrance is ongoing with excavation works expected to commence in May
- Excavation for the eastern tunnel ventilation shaft (TVS) and goods lift are ongoing
- Site establishment for the western TVS are continuing until May.








STATE LIBRARY

- TBM 2 (Meg) broke through into State Library Station on 11 February 2021 and was relaunched in early-April 2021
- Excavation, formwork installation and concrete pours are continuing for the top-down construction of the La Trobe Street and Little La Trobe Street shafts
- Permanent structure and lining works are taking place along the arch of the central cavern. This includes the installation of waterproofing materials, formwork and concrete.
- Central cavern works will be the main focus underground until June-2021.

- The tunnelling team is working to strip all of the pipes from the completed tunnel, before they can begin disassembling the TBM and bringing the pieces back to Anzac Station through the tunnel
- The Shrine of Remembrance station entrance roof is complete and is now being backfilled
- The next sections of the station's concourse level are being constructed in the northern and southern ends of the station box.

TUNNELLING IN THE CBD – PROGRESS UPDATE

- Two of the four tunnel boring machines (TBMs) digging the Metro Tunnel have reached their final destination in Melbourne's CBD
- TBM Millie arrived at Town Hall Station, 25 metres beneath Swanston Street, after tunnelling under the Yarra River from the east. TBM Joan arrived soon after, coming from the State Library Station site
- TBMs Alice and Meg will complete their final sections of the Metro Tunnel's twin 9km tunnels in coming weeks. This significant milestone will mark the completion of all TBM digging works for the project
- After all the TBMs have arrived at Town Hall Station they will be dismantled and removed from the site. Roadheaders will then continue digging the rail platform tunnels within the station box.

FLINDERS STREET FOOTPATH

- The Flinders Street northern footpath reopened to pedestrians at 6pm Thursday 1 April
- The footpath will temporarily close between 6pm and 10pm from Wednesday 28 to Friday 30 April
- These temporary closures will enable the installation of one roller door and pedestrian safety gates
- An additional closure will be required to install the second roller door.


The Metro Tunnel Creative Program and Guru Dudu take you on a silent disco through the NOLA (North of La Trobe Street) precinct, starting at the State Library.


