

Works notification

Utility installation works

Barwise Street and Laurens Street

Mid-November to mid-December 2021

As mentioned in the most recent Arden Precinct construction update, work to replace drainage and watermain lines around the site will commence this month.

What we are doing

- Installing new drainage lines on Laurens Street between Arden Street and Queensberry Street
- Installing a sewer line connection on Laurens Street between Arden Street and Queensberry Street
- Installing water line connections on Laurens Street between Arden Street and Queensberry Street.

What you should be aware of

- Drainage line and sewer connection works will be conducted between 7am and 7pm Monday - Saturday
- These works will generate periods of medium to high levels of noise
- Local detours and traffic controllers will be in place to ensure access during all of these road changes
- In early 2022, road closures will be required again to allow for the relocation of HV power and telecommunication lines. Notification of this will be provided closer to the date.

Traffic changes to be aware of

- From 6am Wednesday 17 November to 7pm Friday 17 December, Laurens Street northbound between Arden and Queensberry Streets will be temporarily realigned to allow the works to be completed. This will close the footpath on the west side of Laurens Street, as well as remove the on-street parking
- A full closure of Laurens Street, between Arden Street and Queensberry Street, will be required for seven days between 6am Wednesday 24 November and 7pm Wednesday 1 December to complete the sewer line and water line connections
- A full closure of Barwise Street will be required for five days between 6am Tuesday 23 November and 5pm Saturday 27 November to complete drainage network installation.
