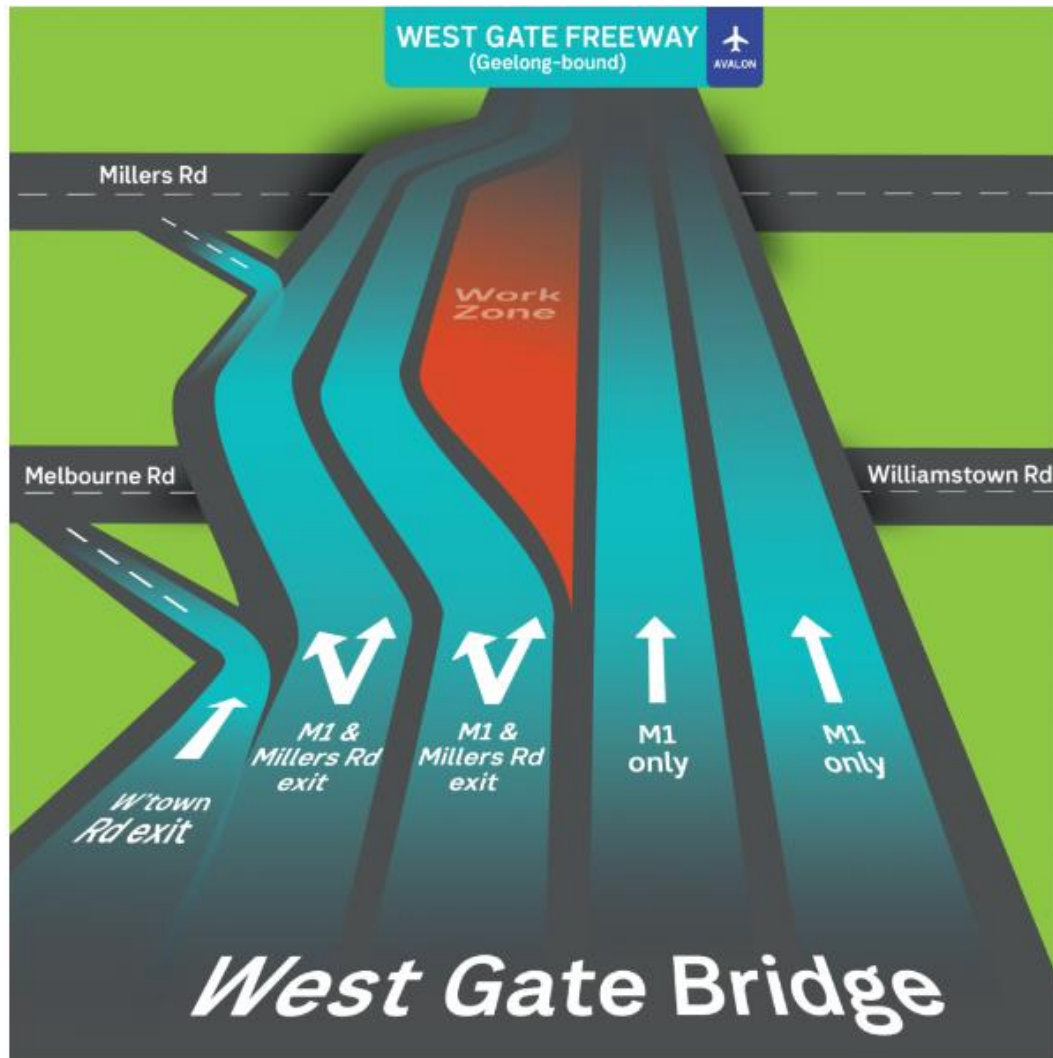

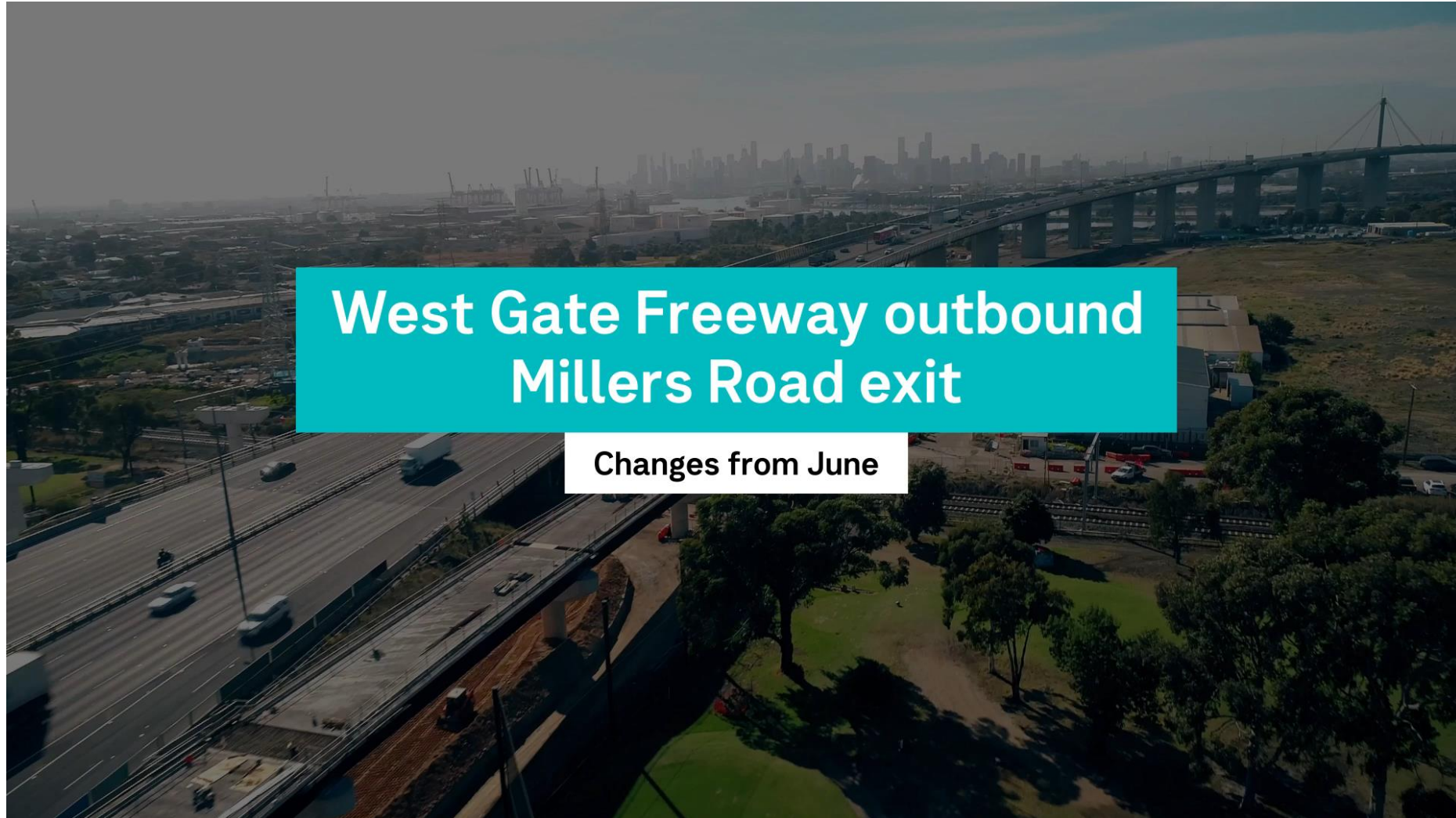


# Millers Road Exit Traffic Switch



- Drivers travelling out of the city heading west, who want to access Millers Road and Williamstown Road, must stay in the left lanes.
- Drivers need to decide on the West Gate Bridge whether they want to exit at Millers Road and move to the left lanes.
- Works include: setup of construction sites to rebuild existing lanes from the ground up, add new lanes and build the inbound tunnel entry.
- Engagement: letter box mailout to the inner west, advertising on billboards, radio, social media posts, educational video on next slide

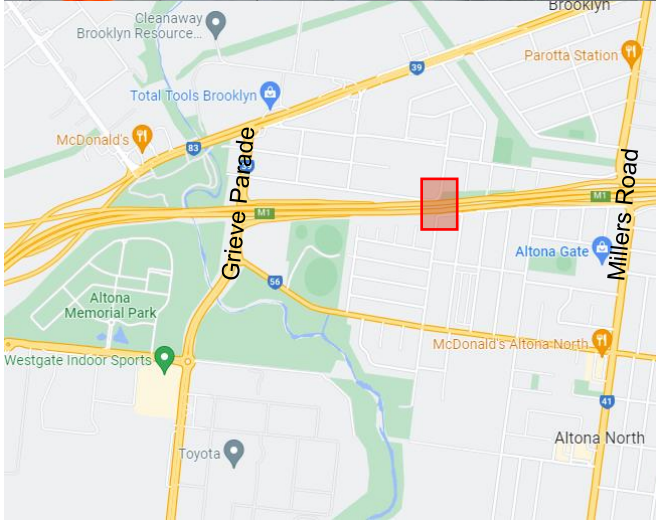
# Noise Walls Progress



- Approximately 3000 of the 3300 concrete sections of noise wall have now been installed
- Approximately 50% completed of all acrylic panels have now been installed
- Approximately 75% of the acrylic panels are expected to be installed by the end of July 2022

# Maribyrnong River bridges

- Major milestone – first girders were lifted into place for the new ramp bridge from MacKenzie Road to the tunnel.
- Four girders have been successfully lifted so far.
- Partial river closures during beam lifts continuing through to mid-July.
- Ongoing engagement with river users and the Harbour Master, latest notification delivered 30 May.



# Footscray Road / Elevated Roadway



- Launching gantry progress:
  - Over 700 metres of spans in place for westbound elevated roadway.
  - Over 300 concrete segments are sitting on top of the columns that form the elevated road's foundations.
- Gantry will change direction and head back east along Footscray Road in mid-July to construct the inbound carriageway.

# Wurundjeri Way



- Upcoming southbound lane closures in July for precast column installation
- These columns will support the new bridges over Wurundjeri Way as part of the Wurundjeri Way extension

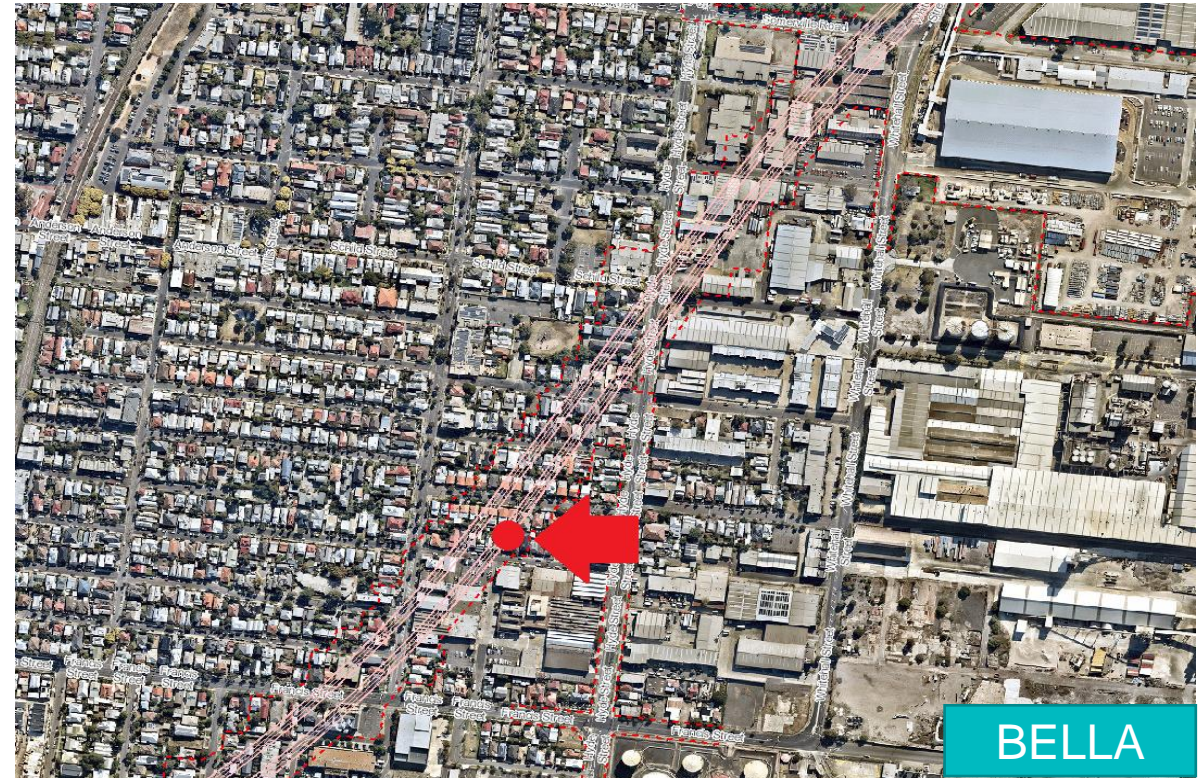
# Tunnelling Progress

# Tunnel Site Visit



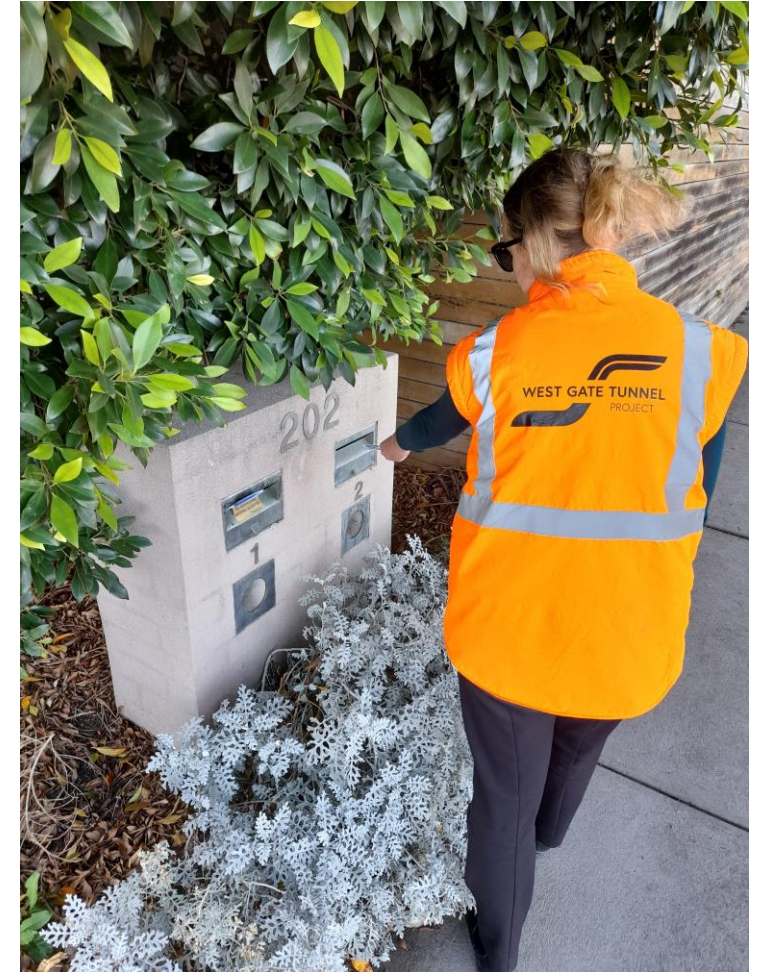
*Josh Bull MP and The Hon Ben Carroll MP came for a visit in May*

- Over the recent months, CPBJH have accommodated a number of site visits for key stakeholders.
- Visitors have included Minister for Transport Infrastructure Jacinta Allan and Minister for Roads and Public Transport Ben Carroll.
- In total we have hosted about 151 visitors in the Tunnels since March.
- Due to the working nature of the tunnels, site visits are very limited.



# Tunnelling - Engagement

- Over 300 notifications have been distributed advising of the TBM approaching.
- 138 letterbox drops have been completed in the last two weeks.
- Installed noise and vibration monitors in several properties along the tunnel alignment.
- 15 enquiries through the call centre over the last month, only one noise complaint.
- Media event to celebrate 1km milestone for TBM 1.



# More Haulage Transportation Information



- The JV produced a spoil and haulage Q&A with Tim Spawton and a new Haulage Clip in cooperation with High Quality to inform the public about complex soil management procedures and haulage transport.

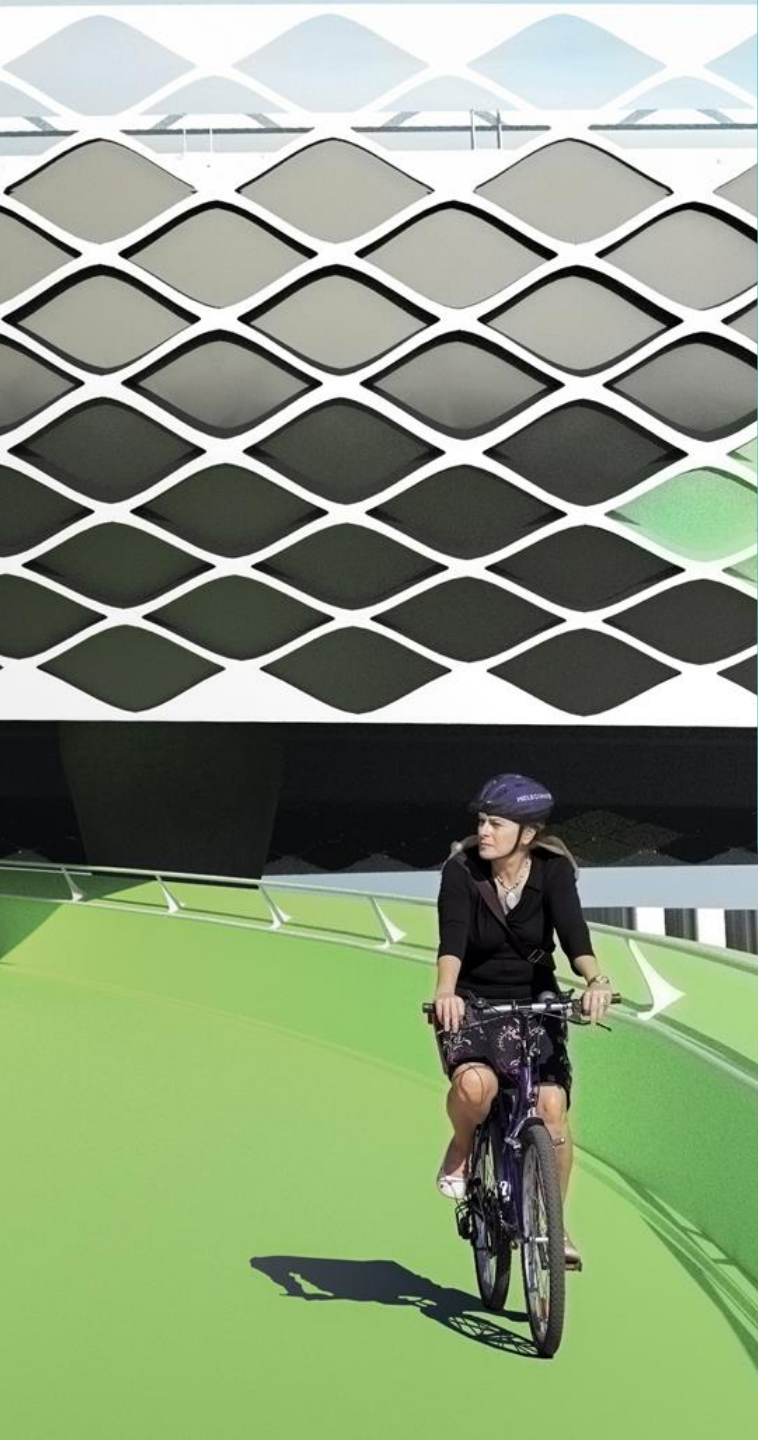
