

# Works notification

## Reinstatement and public realm works

### Royal Parade between the Royal Melbourne Hospital Clinical Sciences Building and Story Street

**From 6 December 2022 to early 2023**

The Parkville Station precinct is moving into the final phase of construction with the start of reinstatement and public realm works.

Throughout the Parkville precinct, staged reinstatement and public realm works have commenced and will continue through until late 2023. These works will include service relocations, footpath, kerb and road pavement construction, traffic signal modifications and the installation of bus stops, street furniture, lighting and landscaping.

Reinstatement and public realm works will take place up to property boundaries, including on footpaths and directly adjacent to building entrances.

Reinstatement and public realm works will be undertaken in the Royal Parade northbound service lane, between the Royal Melbourne Hospital's Clinical Sciences Building and Story Street, in several phases from 6 December 2022 to early 2023.

The details below refer to phase one, in the northbound service lane between the Royal Melbourne Hospital's Clinical Sciences Building and the section immediately north of The Royal Melbourne Hospital car park entrance (see map).

Further notification will be provided in January 2023 regarding upcoming phases of work.

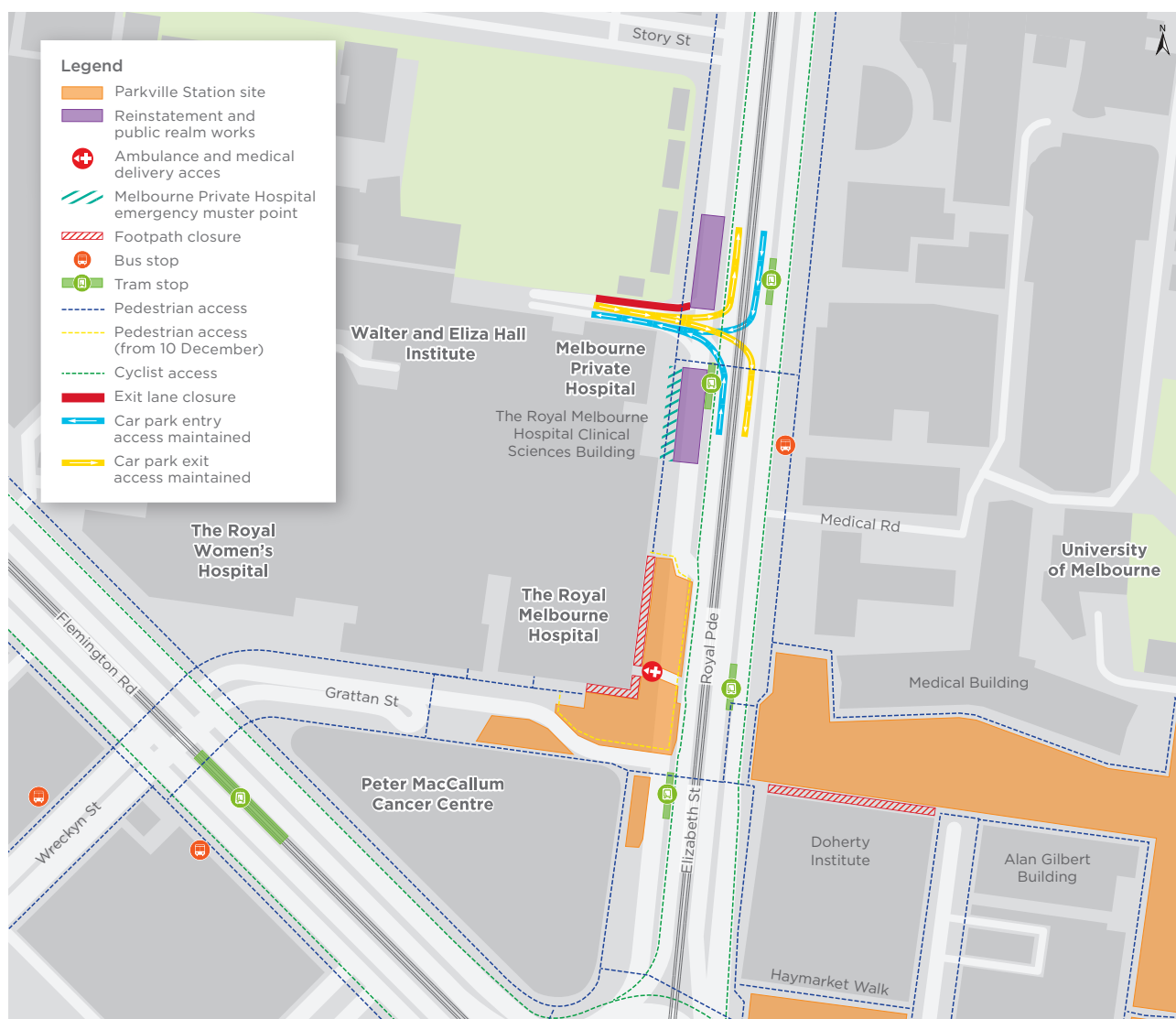
#### What we are doing

- Site establishment including installing traffic barriers, temporary fencing and signage around the work site
- Removing the existing kerbs at pedestrian crossings and road surface using non-destructive digging, excavation and saw cutting of the existing kerb and road surface

- Transporting the excavated kerb and asphalt from site using trucks
- Installing new stormwater drainage and traffic signals
- Laying a new asphalt road surface
- Using a range of plant to complete these works including excavators for trenching, a road profiler to remove the existing asphalt and asphalt paver and rollers to lay the new road surface.

#### What to be aware of

- The Royal Parade northbound service lane between Grattan Street and Story Street will be closed to vehicles except for ambulances and authorised deliveries
- Stroke ambulance access will be maintained via the northbound service lane. Access will be managed under local traffic control
- The left turn exit lane from The Royal Melbourne Hospital car park onto Royal Parade will be closed
- Access in and out of the car park will be maintained via the remaining lanes
- Vehicles exiting The Royal Melbourne Hospital car park travelling northbound will be directed into the Royal Parade inner lane
- Some short-term and emergency vehicle parking on Royal Parade will be occupied during this phase of works
- Cyclists travelling northbound will be directed into the Royal Parade inner lane
- Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained at all times



Indicative only

- The northern east-west crossing in front of the Royal Melbourne Hospital car park on Royal Parade will be closed during these works. The southern east-west crossing will remain open
- Pedestrian access around the site will be maintained at all times
- Traffic management and signage will be in place to safely direct vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians around the work site
- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise, depending on the work activity
- These works are weather dependent
- Once complete, the next phase of this stage of reinstatement and public realm works will

commence on Royal Parade in the service lane, between the Royal Melbourne Hospital's Clinical Sciences Building and Story Street. Further notification will be provided in January 2023
