As part of the West Gate Tunnel Project, we're continuing to build new bridges over the Maribyrnong River. These bridges will support the main carriageway and the entry and exit ramps from Mackenzie Road to the new West Gate Tunnel.

What to expect and when:

As part of construction of the new bridges, there will continue to be intermittent full closures of the Maribyrnong River

south of Shepherd Bridge during the day. These closures are required so that we can safely install bridge segments as part of the construction of the new bridges. 
