

# Monthly construction update

## Domain precinct

September 2023

Works to construct the Metro Tunnel's Anzac Station are progressing. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area in September.

Over winter, crews made good progress on station and public realm construction, including construction of the Anzac Station entrances, fit out of the station and works along St Kilda Road to set up work areas for the final drainage, kerbing, utility and bike lanes installations.

In September works will continue to realign, rebuild and resurface roads and build public spaces in the area. These include resurfacing key intersections, construction of Albert Road and Albert Road linear park and construction of St Kilda Road's medians, kerbs and bike lanes.

Underground works will continue at the station entrances and inside the station box. These include fit out works, and important concreting and water proofing works at the Albert Road station entrance.

### Construction snapshot

Construction works within the Anzac Station precinct during September 2023 include:

- Kerb and footpath works
- Station entrance construction
- Albert Road linear park construction
- Utility connections
- St Kilda Road median works
- Station box construction and fit out
- Road resurfacing works
- Testing trains in the tunnel.

#### Normal construction hours

7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday  
7am to 1pm, Saturdays.



#### Out of hours

Some works are required to take place out of normal construction hours.

24 hour works are sometimes required during peak construction activities.

# Works in your area

## Station entrance construction - Albert Road Reserve

**Albert Road Reserve and Albert Road**  
*Ongoing – 2024*



- Steel tying, formwork and concrete pours for the internal walls and the roof of the station entrance will take place in September. Due to the nature of these works, concrete pours must be continuous and may run past 10pm
- At times, precast concrete elements will be lowered into the station entrance using a crane
- These works will take place until 10pm each night, but there will be times when works will continue 24 hours a day within the station entry.

## Albert Road construction

**Albert Road North**  
*Ongoing – 2024*



- The closure of Albert Road at the St Kilda Road end and works to rebuild sections of Albert Road will continue until 7 September. Once complete, Albert Road will reopen to eastbound and westbound traffic between St Kilda Road and Kings Way
- Other works in September include construction of the green link parkland from St Kilda Road to Kings Way. These works include construction of the hard and soft landscaping, final drainage, kerb, roadway and separated bike lanes
- Pedestrian and vehicle movements will change at times in September. Please expect traffic controllers and signage in place to guide you around the area.

## Resurfacing of key intersections

**Kings Way and Albert Road intersection**  
*Late September to early October*



- As part of the Metro Tunnel Project, the intersection of Kings Way and Albert Road will be resurfaced with new asphalt and new line marking
- These works will take place each night from Monday to Thursday for three weeks starting in late September. To minimise disruption to traffic these works must take place at night when there is less traffic
- More information about these works will be provided closer to the date of works.

**Toorak Road and St Kilda Road intersection**

*Late September to early October*



- As part of the Metro Tunnel Project, the intersection of Toorak Road and St Kilda Road will be resurfaced with new asphalt and new line marking
- These works will take place for six nights in late September and early October. To minimise disruption to traffic these works must take place at night when there is less traffic
- More information about these works will be provided closer to the date of works.

## St Kilda Road utility, median, kerbing and footpath works

**Rectification and finishing works**  
**Between Park Street and Coventry Street**  
*Ongoing throughout 2023*



- Rectification and finishing works will take place in early September. To safely do these works, they must take place at night away from traffic when St Kilda Road can be closed. These works include cutting of the road and asphaltting
- These works are expected to generate periods of high-levels of noise associated with saw cutting
- More information about these works will be provided closer to the date of works.

**Kerb and footpath works**  
**Bowen Lane to Bowen Crescent**

*Ongoing until early November 2023*



- Construction of the drainage, kerbs, footpath, roadway and garden beds will continue in September
- There will be pedestrian diversions around the site while final footpath asphaltting takes place. Access to buildings in this section of St Kilda Road will be maintained at all times
- Utility works will take place on Bowen Crescent in September. These works will require a short term lane and footpath closure. More information will be provided closer to the works
- Landscaping and kerbing of the median will commence in September.

**Utility connections**  
**Park Street to Domain Road**

*Ongoing*



- Installation of inground services, footpaths, kerbs and roadways will continue on the surface within the main construction site.

## Separated bike lane installations

**St Kilda Road, between Bowen Crescent and Arthur Street**

*Ongoing until October 2023*



- Works to construct the new separated bike lanes, stormwater and gas line on the northbound and southbound lanes of St Kilda Road continue. These works involve non-destructive digging, saw cutting, excavation and installation of poles, conduits, bike lanes and asphaltting
- Once works are complete, barrier removal and line marking will take place to set up the construction areas. To minimise disruption to traffic these works must take place at night when there is less traffic
- These works include asphaltting and using construction vehicles to place barriers
- Planting will also take place in some areas of the median.

## Station entrance construction – Shrine of Remembrance

### Domain Road

Ongoing



- Works have commenced on the internal fit out of the station entrance. We will install the front and back of house stairs, escalators and precast concrete elements
- Works under the station roof will continue overnight.

## Station box construction and fit out

### Concourse and platform level of station box

Ongoing



- Internal fit out of the station continues 24 hours a day underground. This includes installing flooring, mechanical, electrical, plumbing fit out and painting
- Plant and HV equipment continue to be installed in back-of-house rooms.

## St Kilda Road street light installation and resurfacing works

### St Kilda Road, between Coventry Street and Toorak Road

12 to 15 September 2023



- Works to install street lights along St Kilda Road and resurface the St Kilda Road and Park Street intersection will take place in September. Once these works are complete, the right turn from Park Street to St Kilda Road will reopen
- To safely complete these works, St Kilda Road will be closed in both directions for three nights, between Dorcas Street and Kings Way, while trams aren't running
- These works include resurfacing works, moving barriers, installing utility connections at Albert Road and Park street, line marking, street pole installation, installation of turf and finishing works
- We will also be removing sections of the wooden hoarding on the platform of the Anzac tram stop to provide additional space for passengers
- These works are expected to generate periods of high-levels of noise associated with saw cutting to install the utility connections under St Kilda Road.

## **Traffic and transport impacts**

### **Oversized deliveries**

- While most deliveries to the Anzac Station site will occur during normal hours, some deliveries to and from site that are classified as ‘oversized’ will be required outside of normal working hours and overnight. Whenever oversized deliveries are expected overnight, crews will be reminded of noise requirements on site.

### **Park Street**

- The right turn from Park Street onto St Kilda Road is expected to reopen in mid-September
- In early September, the east / west pedestrian crossing at Park Street will be closed to finish the final roadway.

### **St Kilda Road southbound**

- Changes to cycling conditions with cyclists to merge with vehicles between Park Street and Domain Road
- The right turn from St Kilda Road onto Kings Way remains closed
- The northern pedestrian crossing at the Toorak Road tram stop will temporarily close in September
- St Kilda Road will be closed each night in both directions, from 8pm to 6am, 12 to 15 September, with the southbound lanes closed between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road.

### **St Kilda Road northbound**

- Traffic changes are in place from Arthur Street to Bowen Crescent
- Changes to cycling conditions with cyclists to merge with vehicles between Toorak Road and Bowen Crescent

- The left turn from Kings Way to St Kilda Road remains closed
- St Kilda Road will be closed each night in both directions, from 8pm to 6am, 12 to 15 September, with the northbound lanes closed between Kings Way and Dorcas Street.

### **Albert Road construction**

- Until Thursday 7 September, Albert Road is closed at the St Kilda Road end to rebuild sections of Albert Road. Access in and out of Albert Road will be via Kings Way
- Some parking will temporarily be removed during September between 38 Albert Road and St Kilda Road.

### **Bowen Lane**

- Utility works require a closure of Bowen Lane until Saturday 16 September
- A temporary pedestrian detour will remain in place from Bowen Lane to Bowen Crescent while stormwater and gas works are underway in this area. Access to buildings will be maintained at all times.

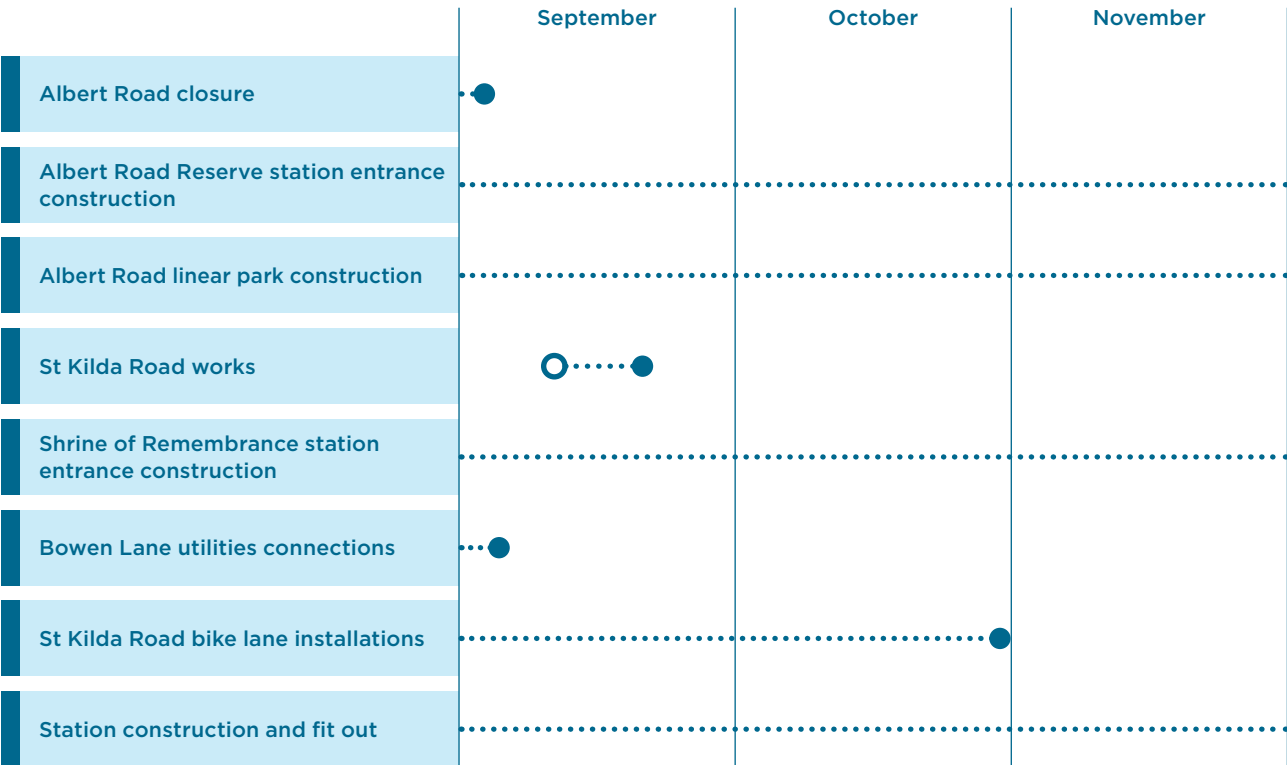
### **Kings Way and Albert Road intersection**

- The intersection will be closed each night from Monday to Thursday for three weeks starting in late September.

### **Toorak Road and St Kilda Road intersection**



- The intersection will be closed each night for six nights in late September.
