

Works notice

24-hour rail tunnel entrance worksKensington

Sunday 24 September to Wednesday 27 September

Major works at the Metro Tunnel's western entrance are nearing completion. As part of the final stages of works, crews will be installing walkway lighting within the entrance to the tunnel.

What we are doing

- Working out of hours to install walkway lighting and cabling within the tunnel entrance
- These works will require the use of hi-rail equipment, an elevated work platform and the use of hand tools

What to be aware of

- Traffic management will intermittently be in place on Childers Street to assist with construction vehicle movements between the tunnel entrance and project site at 5-39 Hobsons Road
- The southern footpath on Childers Street will be closed and a pedestrian diversion to the northern footpath will be in place
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise
- The Hobsons Road project site will be used outside of normal construction hours during this time

- Temporary light towers and generators may be required during this time. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- Access to properties will be maintained
- As these works are within the rail corridor, they will need to occur when trains are not running, outside normal construction hours.
