# Cultural Heritage management plans (CHMP) contingencies



Regular CHMP compliance reviews are undertaken during works. If non-compliance is identified then works must STOP, and the non-compliance be reported to the regulator.

If you identify suspected CHMP non-compliance, contact your Environment Lead.

If you identify suspected Aboriginal cultural heritage material, contact your Environment Lead.



**For more information, request a copy of the approved CHMP.**



If suspected human remains are identified, then works must STOP. Contact Victoria Police 131 4444 and State Coroner's Office 1300 309 519 immediately.

If suspected Aboriginal cultural heritage material is identified, then works within 10m must STOP. The discovery will be investigated by a heritage advisor and the RAP.
