

Your new Croydon Station precinct

Final landscaping design

Planting around the new station precinct will include narrow-leaved peppermint eucalyptus trees along with dwarf banksia, kangaroo grass, and rock daisy.



Narrow-leaved peppermint

The landscaped basin on Croydon Road will contain silver stringybark and narrow-leaved peppermint eucalyptus trees. Other planting in the area will include purple coral pea, mat rush, and kangaroo grass.

Planting in front of the retaining wall on Railway Crescent will include blueberry ash, weeping bottlebrush and golden wattle trees along with blue flax lily and button everlastings.

Planting along the rail corridor at Gallipoli Parade and Wicklow Avenue will include black sheoak, golden wattle, and blackwood trees as well as mat rush and trailing goodenia.

The new Devon Street road connection and shared use path will be lined with dwarf yellow and dwarf lemon scented gum trees along with white correa, coastal rosemary, and nodding salt bush.

The landscaped basin on Railway Grove will include gum trees, such as white peppermint and river peppermint, as well as mat rush and blue flax lily.

Leading into the new Croydon Transport Hub from Main Street, you will be greeted by dwarf spotted gum, smooth barked apple and honey locust trees, along with dwarf banksia and white correa.
