

Works notice



Little La Trobe Street long term road closure

From Tuesday 19 March 2024

Construction of the Metro Tunnel Project's State Library Station has entered a new phase, and includes works on the main station entrance building, construction of two above ground structures on the Little La Trobe Street site, fit-out of the underground station and reinstatement of community space. To carry out these works safely, a long-term closure of Little La Trobe Street between Elizabeth and Swanston streets is required.



When we'll be working

Little La Trobe Street site working hours

- **7am to 3am, Monday to Friday and 7am to 6pm, Saturdays**

La Trobe Street site working hours

- **24-hours, Monday to Friday**
- **7am to 12am, Saturdays and Sundays**

Road closure of Little La Trobe Street

- **24-hours, from 7am Tuesday 19 March 2024** for up to seven months

Some works may be required to take place out of the hours listed above.

- Aboveground structure works involving the use of trucks, cranes, elevated work platforms, rattle guns and hand tools, and other tools and equipment required for the delivery and installation of pre-cast elements, roof steel and sheeting; cladding and glazing for building façades and installation of acoustic and external louvres
- Set up and use of a mobile crane on the road surface within the road closure
- Installation of mechanical, electrical and plant
- Service works involving the use of a non-destructive digging truck
- Reinstating the kerb and gutters
- Truck movements to the La Trobe Street site, via Little La Trobe Street, will be maintained from Swanston Street, and from Elizabeth Street as part of ongoing works to construct the foyer and fit-out the seven-storey deep underground station.
- Local vehicle access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times
- Pedestrian access on Little La Trobe Street between Swanston and Elizabeth streets will be maintained. The pedestrian crossing with pram ramp will be relocated to the west of the road closure (see map for new location)
- There will be changes to parking spaces on Little La Trobe Street under the new arrangement. More information will be provided ahead of these changes and signage will be updated accordingly
- Traffic management will be in place to safely guide pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists around the work area
- Non-Metro Tunnel works are continuing under a northbound lane closure on Elizabeth Street. It is expected that this arrangement will be in place until May 2024. Motorist access to Little La Trobe Street during these works will be from a southbound direction only.

What to be aware of

- There will be no through access to Little La Trobe Street from Swanston Street for motorists or cyclists (see map)
- Motorist access to and from Little La Trobe Street and Literature Lane will be maintained via Elizabeth Street (see map)
- A two-way traffic flow arrangement will be in place between Elizabeth Street and Baskerville Lane (see map)

Where

- Little La Trobe Street, between Elizabeth and Swanston streets.

- Concrete barrier and hoarding installation



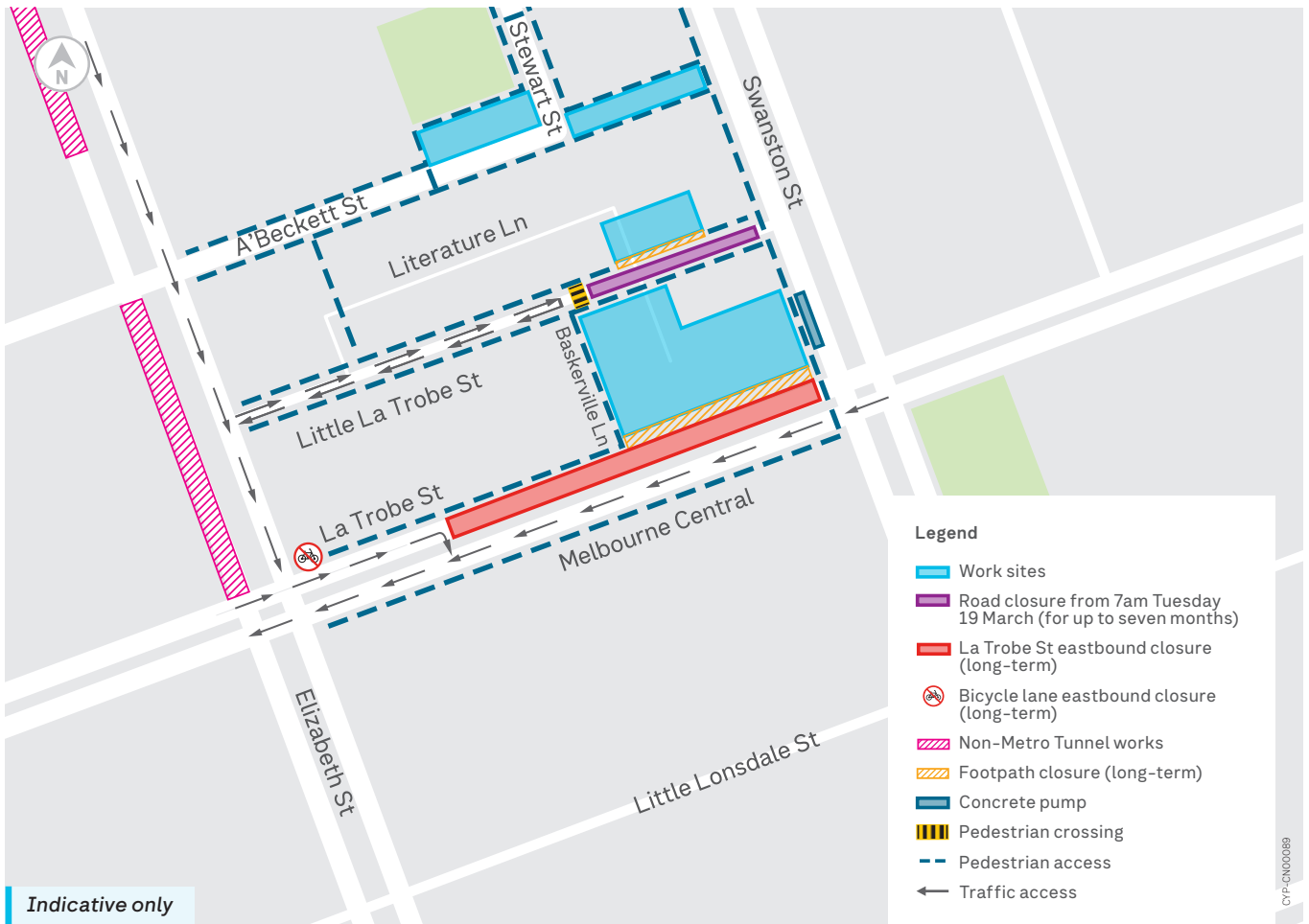
