## Grattan Street reopening

### Grattan Street

Mid-June 2024 onwards

With major works at Parkville Station now complete, Grattan Street will fully reopen to general traffic in the coming days.



#### When we'll be working

- From **mid-June** onwards

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

#### What we'll be doing

- Removing the water barriers currently in place on Grattan Street (at Royal Parade, Berkeley Street and Leicester Street)
- Keeping station infrastructure, including station entrances, tunnel ventilation shafts, goods lift and ancillary buildings fenced off until the Metro Tunnel opens in 2025.

#### What to be aware of

- In the coming days, Grattan Street will reopen to general traffic and cyclists between Royal Parade and Bouverie Street, with an eastbound and westbound lane
- The left turn from Bouverie street to Grattan Street will reopen
- The left turn from Leicester Street to Grattan Street will reopen
- Access for traffic between Berkeley Street and Grattan Street will reopen

- All pedestrian crossings will be open
- A section of the northern Grattan Street footpath will remain closed until late June while reinstatement works are completed
- Buses in the area will continue on their current routes until further notice
- Barry Street will remain closed to traffic as per the approved design.

#### Where

- Grattan Street, between Royal Parade and Bouverie Street

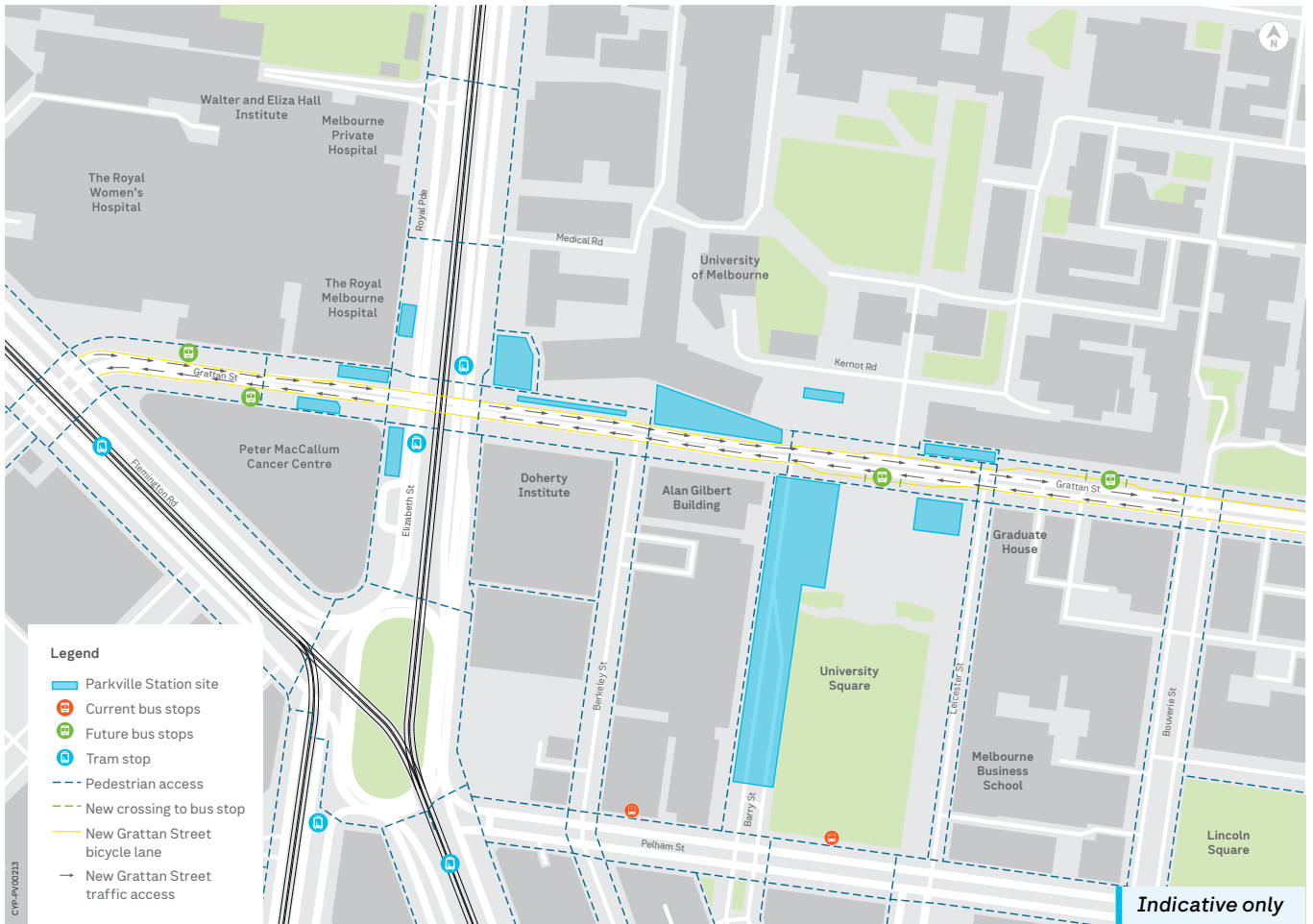
