The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Repositioning temporary fencing adjacent to 1 Albert Road (The Domain)
- Reopening the one-way Albert Road connection to St Kilda Road, south of the Albert Road and St Kilda Road intersection.

What to be aware of

- Following the opening, Albert Road's southern connection to St Kilda Road will function as follows:
 - Two way access between
 Albert Road and 1 Albert Road
 (The Domain) driveway
 - One-way access from 1 Albert Road (The Domain) driveway to St Kilda Road
- This section of road is a shared zone by both vehicles and pedestrians, with right of way for pedestrians
- Upon operation of the station, the pull in bay adjacent to the station lifts will function as a short-term disabled drop off bay
- In the interim, this drop off bay will remain fenced off and act as a drop off area for any materials being delivered to site for final completion works for Anzac Station.




