## Gantry removal works requiring southern footpath closure

#### **Collins Street**

Tuesday 22 to Thursday 31 October 2024

Works will take place to prepare and remove the gantry on Collins Street at the City Square site entrance.



### When we'll be working

#### Gantry removal preparation

- We'll be working from 7am on Tuesday 22 October until 7am on Friday 25 October
- The footpath will be reopened from 6pm to 10pm on Thursday 24
  October to support Regent Theatre show times.

#### Gantry removal

 We'll be working from 7pm on Wednesday 30 October until 6am on Thursday 31 October.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

#### What we'll be doing

- Preparatory works for the removal of the Collins Street gantry
- Removing the overhead gantry on Collins Street (refer map for location).

#### What to be aware of

- These works will generate some medium level noise during the night
- Works will include the use of elevated plant, hand tools and the tower crane
- The Collins Street southern footpath, between Regent Place and Swanston Street, will be closed for the works. Pedestrians will need to cross at Russell Street to continue west on Collins Street and at Swanston Street to continue east on Collins Street
- There will be some full and single lane closures of westbound Collins Street between Russell Street and Swanston Street as required to facilitate gantry removal works. Local access will be maintained under contraflow from Russell Street and Elizabeth Street.

#### Where

 Collins Street southern footpath between Regent Place and Swanston Street (refer map for location and pedestrian detours).


