Collins Street southern footpath closure

Collins Street

Early-February to early-March 2025

As we prepare to return a revitalised City Square to the community, above ground works are well underway including reinstatment of the Collins Street southern footpath. To safely complete these works, a month-long footpath closure is required adjacent to the site.



When we'll be working

 From early-February to early-March 2025, we'll be working 24-hours a day, Monday to Saturday.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Completing sewerage connections
- Installing new station signage and lighting, kerbing, pavement and bike hoops
- Removing the concrete pump and temporary hoarding
- Constructing the stairs which will lead passengers to the Town Hall Station entrance at City Square.

What to be aware of

- The Collins Street southern footpath, adjacent to the City Square site, will be closed to pedestrians. Please refer to the map below for location
- Pedestrians will be required to use the northern side of Collins Street to travel through the area
- Access to businesses, residential buildings and hotels will be maintained at all times
- These works will generate some periods of medium to high level noise and some vibration.

Where

- Collins Street between Swanston Street and Regent Place.


