## Upcoming works update Site investigations occurring across the alignment in April Monash site investigations to commence from mid-April 2023 Works will be staged across a four-week period Sequencing TBC Use of hand-held equipment and vacuum trucks to investigate underground services. Traffic changes including lane closures, road closures, vehicle detours, car park closures and minor pedestrian detours. 3. LOR Engagement with key impacted stakeholders ongoing Both day and night works will occur Letterbox drops to occur along Howleys Road, including door knocks to highly impacted stakeholders. Utility relocation (power, gas, telecoms, site establishment) works are planned to commence in Notting Hill in mid-2023 and will continue to early 2025.
