	Watsonia site update – Gantries have been installed to help build the concrete supports for the smoke duct components (being installed later this year). More than 1,000 culverts have now been installed in the NB tunnel.
	Blamey Road site update – Building the basement walls and columns of the northerns ventilation structure
	Lower Plenty site update – Constructing the roof slabs for the on and off ramps, and road widening works underway on Lower Plenty Road.

TBMs Gillian and Zelda broke through at the LPR site in March. They're now being traversed through the portal and undergoing maintenance before resuming their journey to Bulleen in the coming weeks.

Silk Street bridge update – Works planned to upgrade the bridge from May (Q2/Q3 2025). The new design will enhance safety for local students and the community.

Delays expected with traffic changes during works.

CB – What safety measures are in place for the school children regarding the Silk Street bridge upgrade works?

DH – Acknowledged the project is working closely with key stakeholders to make sure detours are in place and communicated for schoolchildren accessing the school.

JRi - Noted the main span removal works will occur over the school holidays.

Community engagement

24 VCE students from Loyola College visited the Watsonia Hub on 27 March for a presentation and panel discussion exploring community conflict, decision-making processes and issues management on the project. The session supported their outdoor education and environmental studies.

Two community pop-ups held on 29 March at Coleen Reserve and 12 April at Mercedes Court in Rosanna. Another community popup was held at Greensborough Plaza on 30 April with the M80 team also attending. Great engagement and questions asked.

M80 Ring Road - Trader Update

Community engagement snapshot

- Rail occupation reflection/feedback
- Relocation and respite
- Community outreach

Spotlight on Hurstbridge Line occupation

- Over 250 in person check ins
- 1500+ interactions with the community

84 frontline households offered relocation, 48 chose to stay home

600+ respite items such as headphones, air purifiers and vouchers to delivered to local homes close to the train line

Utility works in the Interface Zone (Watsonia)

- Utility works at the intersection of Watsonia Road and Greensborough Highway commenced on 16 March and is being completed in stages until mid-May.
- Overnight works to minimise impacts to businesses.
- Regular engagement with traders.

Window and exterior building clean planned for businesses closest to works.

Watsonia RSL ANZAC Day service – M80RRA installed two VMS boards along Greensborough Road to promote Anzac Day.

Utility works in the South Zone (Greensborough)

- Proactive briefings for utility upgrades followed by regular updates as crews upgrade utilities around Greensborough Road and Grimshaw Street,
- Weekly cleaning during rail occupation for businesses in the rail corridor

'Be a good neighbour' parking initiative to prevent crews parking in residential streets.

RM – Project has engaged with businesses around the project area. Offered to businesses based on their engagement with the project and impact. Approached a number of businesses thought to be good for the group but uptake has been limited.

JR – Noted project drops off pamphlets, could they do a similar thing with businesses? **Action** – Project to investigate whether a DL or pamphlet for traders to join NBLG.

JR – Report shared not long before NBLG with businesses and noted after reading through business EPRs wasn't too specific - possible to find out further detail on which business were audited and how they were tested and what result (not passed). Also noted business amenity; are businesses asked?

Action - Business EPRs to be discussed next meeting.

JR – Requested early access, if possible, to consult with UDLP submission.

RM – Acknowledged that traders would like to take part in the UDLP consultation stage and will advise next steps as soon as they become available.

CB – Asked where the UDLP work is sitting, as not aware that they had started.

JN – Working group has been established and looking through when we can go to exhibition; looking into the late part of the year.

SD – Qualified that the designers are yet to be appointed.

CB – Noted importance that traders and Councils get awareness of the UDLP and feedback in consultation phase.

MM – Asked if the project can keep the wayfinding promotional support open as continue working through with RF and teams.

RM – Noted that the project will collaborate between Council and project for wayfinding. Something more tangible for next meeting. Second action (Rania) open for next meeting.
