

# Heatherton and Clarinda works update

# September 2025

Works are underway in Heatherton and Clarinda to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

#### What we are doing

#### Train stabling facility, Heatherton

- Building the eastern tunnel entrance (ETE) and western tunnel entrance (WTE)
- Building a permanent network support facility (NSF)
- Moving underground and above ground services.

#### Tunnel boring machine (TBM) launch site, Clarinda

- Building the Clarinda tunnel access structures (TAS)
- Connecting underground services.

7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am – 1pm Saturday

#### Extended works

6pm – 10pm Monday to Friday and 1pm – 10pm Saturday

#### Night works

6pm – 7am Monday to Sunday 24-hour works

Train stabling facility west, Heatherton	© Ongoing to late-2025  ⚠ Ongoing to late-2025	<ul> <li>Building the WTE including earthworks, concreting, guide wall construction, diaphragm wall construction, and piling</li> <li>Site investigations</li> <li>Safe removal of hazardous material</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>To safely deliver works, some construction works including concrete pouring will need to be undertaken until 10pm</li> <li>Workers in specialised protective clothing as we continue safe removal of hazardous materials</li> <li>Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust</li> <li>Truck movements and delivery of large machinery for up to three nights</li> </ul>

Old Dandenong Road, Heatherton	☼ ● Ongoing to late-October 2025	Moving and connecting underground and above ground services	— Intermittent northbound lane and road closures for up to two weeks between Kingston Road and Madden Road from early–September to late–October  — Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust

Kingston Road, Heatherton	<b>⇔ ©</b> Ongoing to late-October 2025	<ul> <li>Road reinstatement</li> <li>Site deliveries</li> <li>Moving and connecting underground and above ground services</li> <li>Traffic barrier movements</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Intermittent overnight road closures between Nicholas Grove and Clayton Road from late-August to mid-October</li> <li>Intermittent westbound closures between Pine Lane and Dingley Bypass for up to two weeks from early-September to late-October</li> <li>Changed traffic conditions between Nicholas Grove and Clayton Road with traffic management in place</li> <li>Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust</li> <li>Changes to 631 bus route including closure of some bus stops between Nicholas Grove and Clayton Road</li> <li>Visit ptv.vic.gov.au to plan your journey</li> </ul>
Clayton Road, Clayton South	September 2025	<ul> <li>Site investigations</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Changed traffic conditions between Victory Road and Ryans Road</li> </ul>
TBM launch site, Clarinda	⊗ Ongoing to late-2025	Building the Clarinda TBM launch site, including civil works, concrete slab construction, site drainage install, diaphragm wall construction, piling and ground improvement	<ul> <li>Changed traffic conditions on Peace Road and Victory Road</li> <li>Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust</li> <li>Increased truck movements day and night</li> </ul>

#### **Impacts**


As with all major infrastructure projects, surrounding communities may experience some impacts during construction. The Project supports businesses and residents to continue to live, work, study and shop in their community.

- Covering trucks to minimise dust
- Monitoring noise, dust and vibration levels
- Using noise blankets and hoarding to minimise noise, dust and light spill
- Safely removing hazardous materials in accordance with regulations
- Using water and dust suppressants
- Maintaining access to homes and businesses.
