Smoke baffle installation

Grattan Street northern footpath, Parkville

From Monday 8 September to early November 2025

Smoke baffle installation will be undertaken from September at Parkville Station on Grattan Street, as the Metro Tunnel prepares to open later in 2025.



When we'll be working

- Monday 8 September to early November
- 7am to 6pm, weekdays
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Establishing a site and intermittently setting up a 20-tonne crane on the northern Grattan Street footpath, in front of the University of Melbourne Medical Building, around the two easternmost station skylights
- Delivering materials to site via Barry Street and lowering them onto the station concourse using the crane
- Installing smoke baffles on the concourse level at the main Grattan Street entrance
- Removing materials using the crane via the station skylight
- Reinstating the skylight glazing and stonework and demobilising the site in early November.

What to be aware of

- When the crane is on site, the northern Grattan Street footpath and eastbound bicycle lane will be closed from Royal Parade to the Grattan Street pedestrian crossing at Berkeley Street
- There are expected to be three closures during daytime working hours in mid-September, three in late September and three in mid-October as part of these works
- Traffic management will be on site during all closures and a pedestrian detour will be in place via the southern Grattan Street footpath and pedestrian crossing at Berkeley Street
- Cyclist access will be maintained via the eastbound traffic lane
- The footpath will remain open when the crane is not on site and during reinstatement works
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and intermittent periods of high-level noise during daytime working hours
- Access to the University of Melbourne Medical Building, and all other local buildings will be fully maintained at all times.


