Site reinstatement works

Bouverie Street, Carlton

Monday 14 September – Friday 30 October 2026

Site reinstatement works will be carried out in Bouverie Street, Carlton between Monday 14 September and Friday 30 October 2026. This will involve the removal of a redundant groundwater monitoring system installed as part of the Metro Tunnel Project.



When we'll be working

- 7am – 6pm, Monday – Friday and 7am – 1pm on Saturdays.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

Upcoming works

In early 2027, work will be carried out in Victoria Street between Bouverie Street and Swanston Street to remove the remaining redundant groundwater monitoring system in the area, installed as part of the Metro Tunnel Project.

We will notify you of the timings of these works in advance to ensure you have time to plan.

What we'll be doing

- Site set up works
- Decommissioning four shipping containers located in the middle of Bouverie Street between Victoria and Queensberry streets. These works include removal of internal and external infrastructure
- Removing the containers, container frame, concrete barriers, generator and services
- Removing the groundwater monitoring system includes cutting into the roadway, removing pits and system infrastructure
- Digging a trench on both sides of Bouverie Street to remove the underground pipes and conduits
- Grouting works
- Road and car park reinstatement.

What to be aware of

- To safely carry out these works, Bouverie Street will be closed between Victoria Street and 61 Bouverie Street
- Local vehicle access will be maintained for residents and businesses requiring access to off-street parking garages/driveways and off-street delivery docks

- To ensure safety while cranes remove the shipping containers, there will be one day in late September when there will be no vehicle access to all areas. Further notification will be provided closer to the date
- Local vehicle access into Bouverie Street will be via Queensberry and Swanston streets
- There will be no on-street parking, including residential permit parking, on Bouverie Street between Victoria Street and 61 Bouverie Street during these works. Alternative parking can be found in Bouverie Street and surrounding streets.
- Pedestrian access along Bouverie Street will be maintained at all times
- All residential and business waste removal services will be maintained during these works
- Traffic controllers will be on site to assist with vehicle and pedestrian movements
- Please expect these works to generate medium levels of noise, with intermittent periods of high levels of noise, and dust
- Once complete, 12 car parks in Bouverie Street will be reinstated.

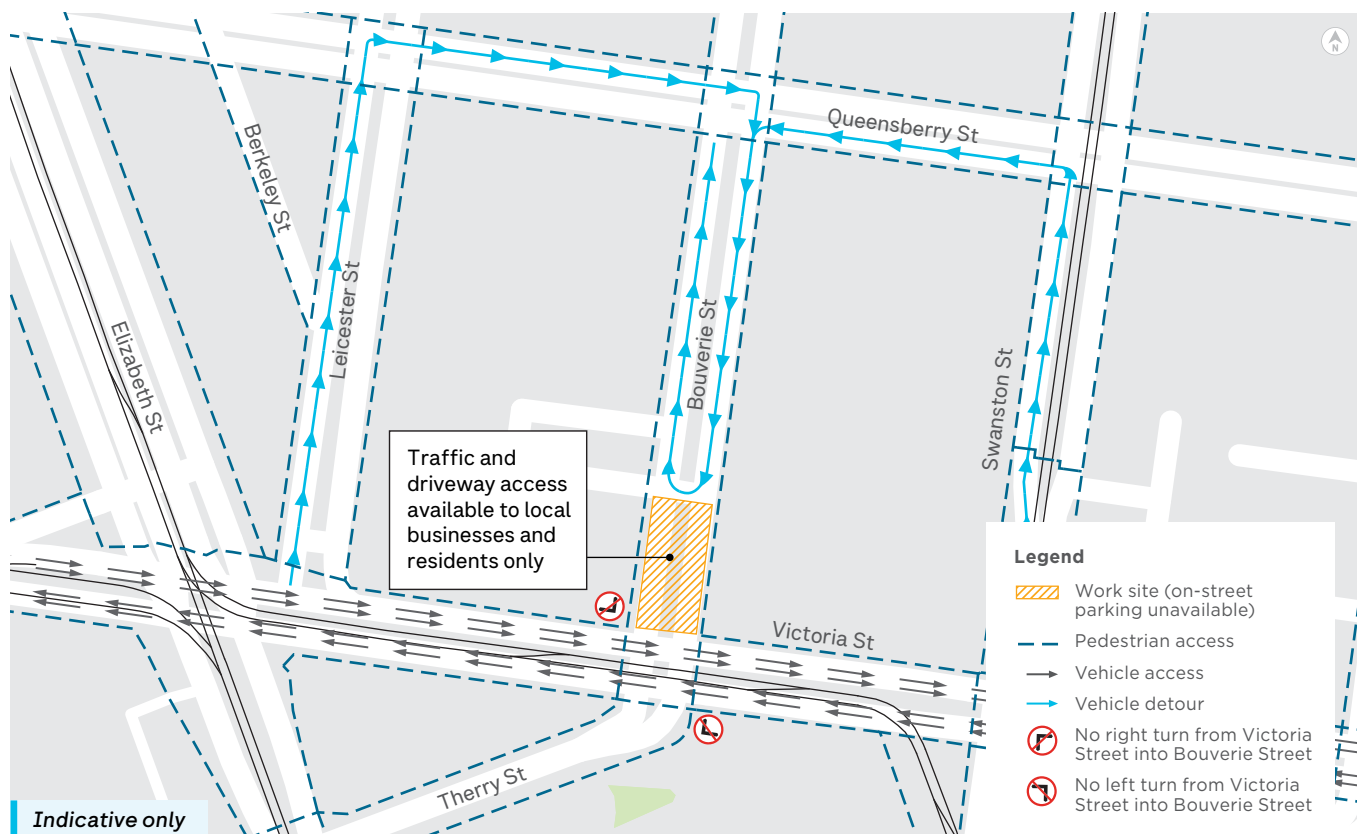
