North East Link will finally complete the missing link in Melbourne's road network while modernising the Eastern Freeway.


It will carry more than 100,000 vehicles a day, slash travel times, get trucks off local roads and link key growth areas in the north and south-east.

Over the last few months we've been:

- developing design ideas for the main interchanges and a new-look Eastern Freeway
- progressing concepts for Doncaster Busway – Melbourne's first dedicated high-speed busway
- investigating different construction types and techniques
- planning an urban design strategy that includes the creation and use of open spaces and walking and cycling links
- starting the specialist studies needed for planning approvals next year.

The work so far isn't final and there are lots of opportunities for you to help shape the project throughout 2018.


