



# Works Notification

## Site Investigations

Eastern Road, Park Street and Kings Way intersection, South Melbourne

February 2022

Ground and utility investigations are taking place to help inform future tram works associated with the Metro Tunnel Project

Rail Projects Victoria will conduct utility investigations at the intersection of Park Street and Kings Way, and ground investigations along Park Street and Eastern Road (see map overleaf).

### What we are doing

#### Ground investigations works will include:

- Non-destructive digging which involves using a vacuum truck to excavate carefully into the ground and locate services
- Geotechnical drilling to understand soil conditions. These works will take place from mid February for up to three weeks
- Reinstating the drilling area after the works
- Survey works will be conducted in conjunction with geotechnical investigations.

#### Utility investigations works will include:

- Non-destructive digging works to locate services
- These works will take up to two nights starting on 14 February.

### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low to moderate levels of noise
- A site compound will be set up to enable works to be carried out safely

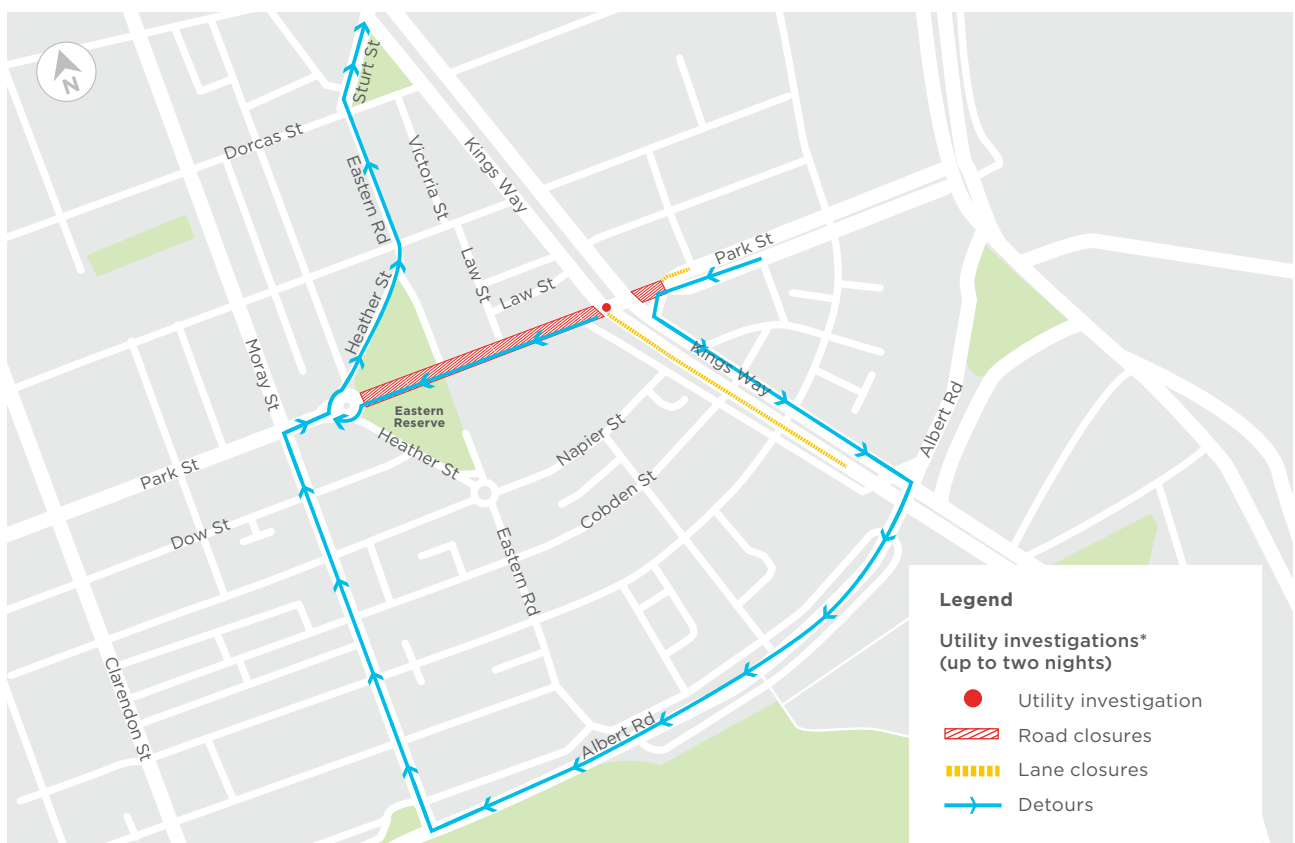
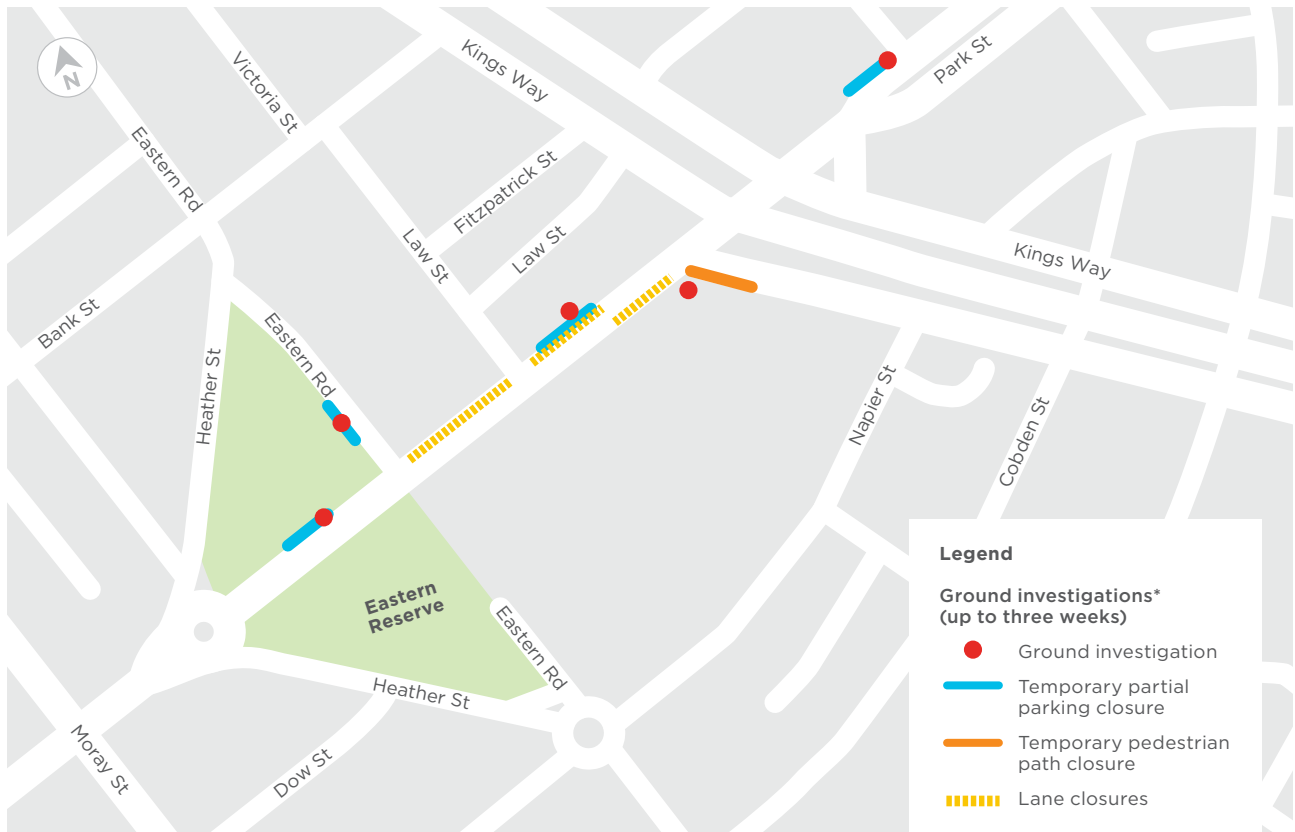
- Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to assist with pedestrian and vehicle access and wayfinding
- Temporary partial closures of on-street parking at the intersection of Eastern Road and Park Street and the intersection of Park Street and Kings Way
- Temporary closure of the pedestrian path at the intersection of Park Street and Kings Way
- The utility works on Kings Way will involve road closures of Park Street and lane closures along Kings Way (northbound) for up to two nights. Detour routes will be provided
- All works will be conducted in line with strict COVID-19 protocols which are being updated regularly based on the latest government advice.

### When

These works will be undertaken in mid February for up to three weeks.



The works will take place outside peak traffic periods to avoid adverse disruption to traffic in the area.

The timing of these works may change depending on weather and ground conditions.



\*Works will be staged with utility investigations preceding ground investigations
